

Monthly update - The Bays, Rozelle

November 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Acciona Ferrovia Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations.

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All work will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans.

Site preparation work: The Bays station site

Essential site preparation work continues within the future station site at The Bays before major construction starts in January 2022. In addition to the geotechnical and utility investigation work already underway, from **early November** AFJV will start building internal access roads within the site and a hardstand area (large concrete slab) to allow building of the construction site.

This work will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 6pm

The work will include:

- Relocating mobile offices
- Upgrading fencing to allow site access and to protect sensitive areas
- Installing erosion and sediment controls
- Cutting grass and removing some vegetation
- Grading and rolling the surface to level the site
- Pouring concrete to form a large hard surface ready for future work
- Grading, rolling and sealing the site access roads

What to expect:

- There may be some noise associated with the work but we will try to minimise this as much as possible
- All work will be carried out within The Bays station construction site
- Strict safety and environmental controls will be in place for all work
- Vehicles will be parked within the construction site

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: trucks, light vehicles, excavators, graders, watercarts, telehandlers, franna cranes, rollers, concrete trucks, concrete pumps and hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

All work will be carried out within The Bays construction site, so there will be no changes to traffic, pedestrian or cycle routes. Internal traffic management measures will be in place for site traffic safety where required.
