

Notification – Sydney Olympic Park

15 October 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Geotechnical investigations

Essential geotechnical investigation work is required to determine the underlying rock conditions at Sydney Olympic Park and inform early design work for Sydney Metro West. This work will commence on **Friday 22 October 2021 for up to four weeks**. Work is being carried out during **standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am-6pm** weather and site conditions permitting. See map overleaf to inform the locations for these works.

Out-of-hours works will be required on Hill Road (near the corner of Hill Road and Pondage Link) **Monday to Friday 8pm-5am**

Work will include:

- Establishing a temporary site with site fencing where required
- Removal of concrete with a handheld concrete saw
- Removing spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck
- Using a truck mounted drill rig to bore below ground level for geotechnical investigations
- Reinstating the area at completion of the work.

What to expect:

- The work will generate some noise and the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- There will be no disruption to the delivery of utility services
- Traffic control and directional signage may be used for the safety of workers and the community
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times for vehicles and pedestrians.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for work includes but is not limited to, excavators, drill rig, vacuum trucks, hand tools, temporary fencing, survey equipment, and light vehicles.
