

Notification – Clyde and surrounding suburbs

29 November 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Ongoing geotechnical, drainage and topographical investigations in Clyde and surrounds

Geotechnical, drainage and topographical investigations are continuing in your area to assist with early planning and design for Sydney Metro West and the future Clyde stabling and maintenance facility.

Most of this work is being done during standard construction hours, **Monday to Friday between 7am to 6pm** and **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**. This work will continue until 23 December.

The survey work on Parramatta Road and Rawson Street will be done at night to minimise the impact on traffic. This work will start on **Monday 6 December 2021** and continue for up to a week **Sunday to Friday 7pm and 5am**.

The safety of the community and our workforce is top priority. All works will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans.

Work will include:

- Non-intrusive drainage and topographical survey work, including opening and inspecting pits
- Cutting concrete and asphalt with a bob-saw for geotechnical investigations
- Removing spoil using a vacuum excavation truck for geotechnical investigations
- Using a truck mounted drill rig to bore below ground for geotechnical investigations
- Back-filling and reinstating the excavated areas after geotechnical works

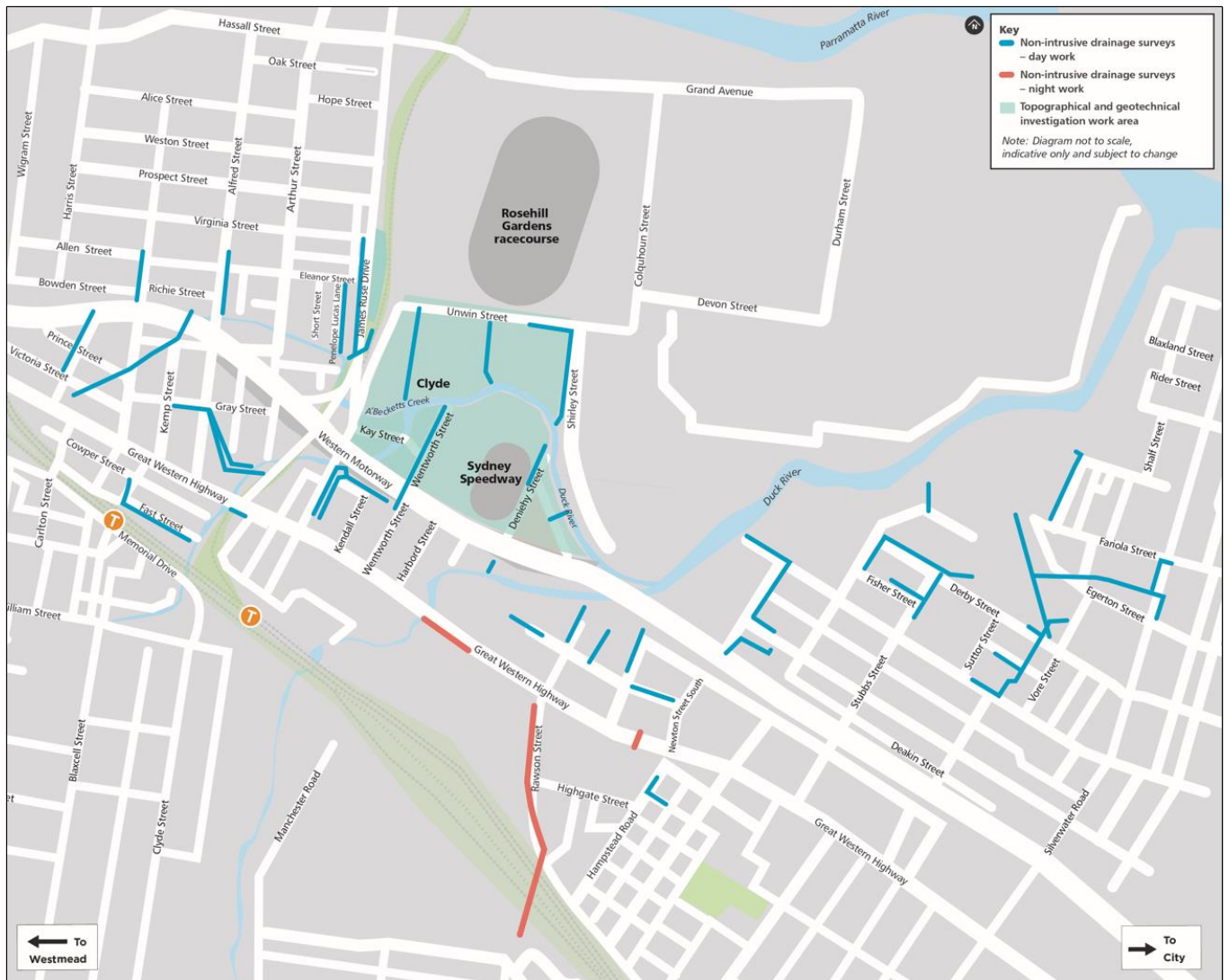
What to expect:

- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- The impacted areas will be reinstated once the work is complete
- Noise impacts will be minimised wherever possible
- Traffic flow will be maintained, but there may be temporary traffic changes in some locations.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to; survey equipment, electromagnetic wands specialised ground penetrating equipment, hand tools, drill rig, generators, excavators, vacuum trucks, bob-saws, concrete saws, temporary fencing and light vehicles.

Location of work

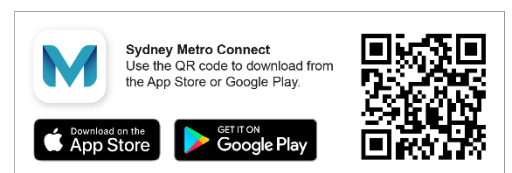
