## **Notification – Pyrmont**

1 November 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

### **Utility surveys: Pyrmont (Out-of-hours)**

Essential survey work will be undertaken by RPS on behalf of Sydney Metro. This work is required to determine the location of underground utilities to assist with planning and design of the Pyrmont Station.

Work is expected to commence on **Monday 8 November 2021 for up to 6 weeks**, weather, site conditions and COVID restrictions permitting. Due to traffic volumes on Pyrmont Bridge Road, Union, Pyrmont and Harris Street and to minimise impacts on the traffic network, work is being done outside of standard construction hours Sunday to Thursday 7pm – 5am. See map overleaf for the location of these works.

**The safety of the community and our workforce is top priority. All work will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measure and plans.**

#### **Work will involve:**

- Locating services and marking out utility locations
- Opening services pits with non-mechanical means
- Capturing details of utility covers, vegetation, road surfaces, buildings and structures, and fences and embankments

#### **What to expect:**

- This work is not expected to be noisy
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- No images will be taken of private property.

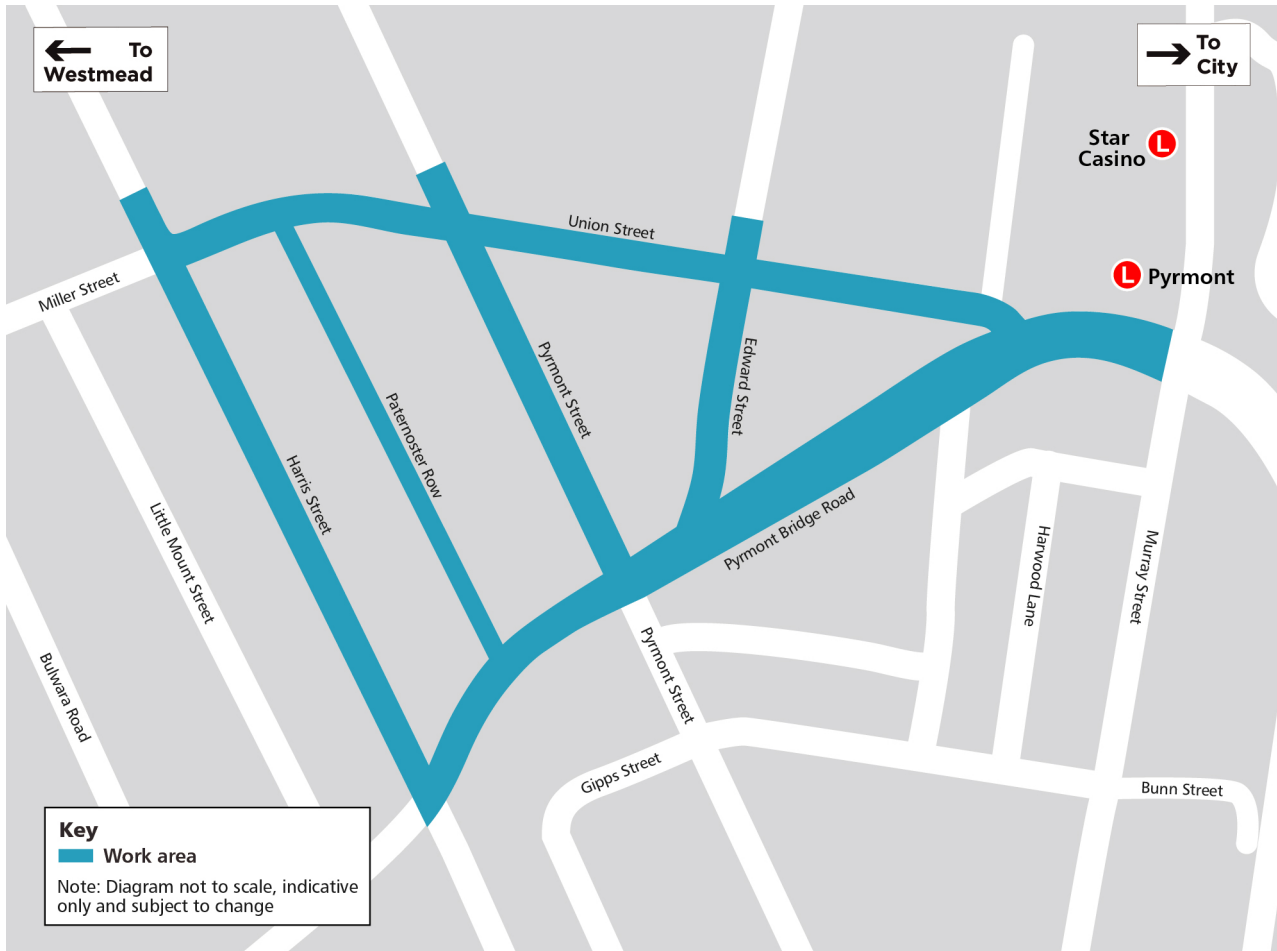
#### **Equipment used:**

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to; hand held survey equipment, mounted tripods, electromagnetic wands, ground penetrating radar and traffic control vehicles.

## Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic control, or partial road closures. The time of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.
