

Project update – Barangaroo Station

January 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66-kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

BESIX Watpac has been awarded the contract to build Barangaroo Station. BESIX Watpac will deliver the station fit-out and associated landscaping and civil works, including the re-alignment of Hickson Road.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work which includes installing metro rail track, power systems, communications and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

Barangaroo Station – upcoming work

In January, the BESIX Watpac team will continue construction activities started in December. Our focus will be fitting out the underground station box and continuing surface work that will enable the realignment of Hickson Road later in 2022. Systems Connect will continue with tunnel fit-out, temporary services installation and delivering plant, material, and equipment to the station site.

The following table provides more information about the activities planned for January 2022. All activities are weather and site conditions permitting.

Utility works including trenching, installation and backfill. Stormwater works including sheet piling and trenching. Watermain works. Demolishing a temporary access bridge near the station entrance area. Removal of traffic signals on Hickson Road. Backfill of the station box area. Delivering building materials and equipment for the station and tunnels. Installing site sheds. <p>Station works (underground)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Structural work including blockwork, structural steel and concreting to prepare the underground station box platforms for doors and escalators. Installing ventilation systems in the station box and tunnels. Completing mechanical and electrical (M&E) works in the tunnels. Completing trackwork in the tunnels.
Northern shaft at Hickson Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Completing and energising the second of two high voltage feeders to Barangaroo station. Delivery, offload and distribution of materials to the tunnels.
Location	Out-of-hours activities
Inside the station box and cross-over cavern	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Delivery of building materials and equipment for the stations and tunnels. Structural works. Fit-out works. Temporary ventilation. Installing equipment and cables in cross passages between Victoria Cross Station and Barangaroo Station.
Hickson Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Installing new services under Hickson Road.

Out of hours works

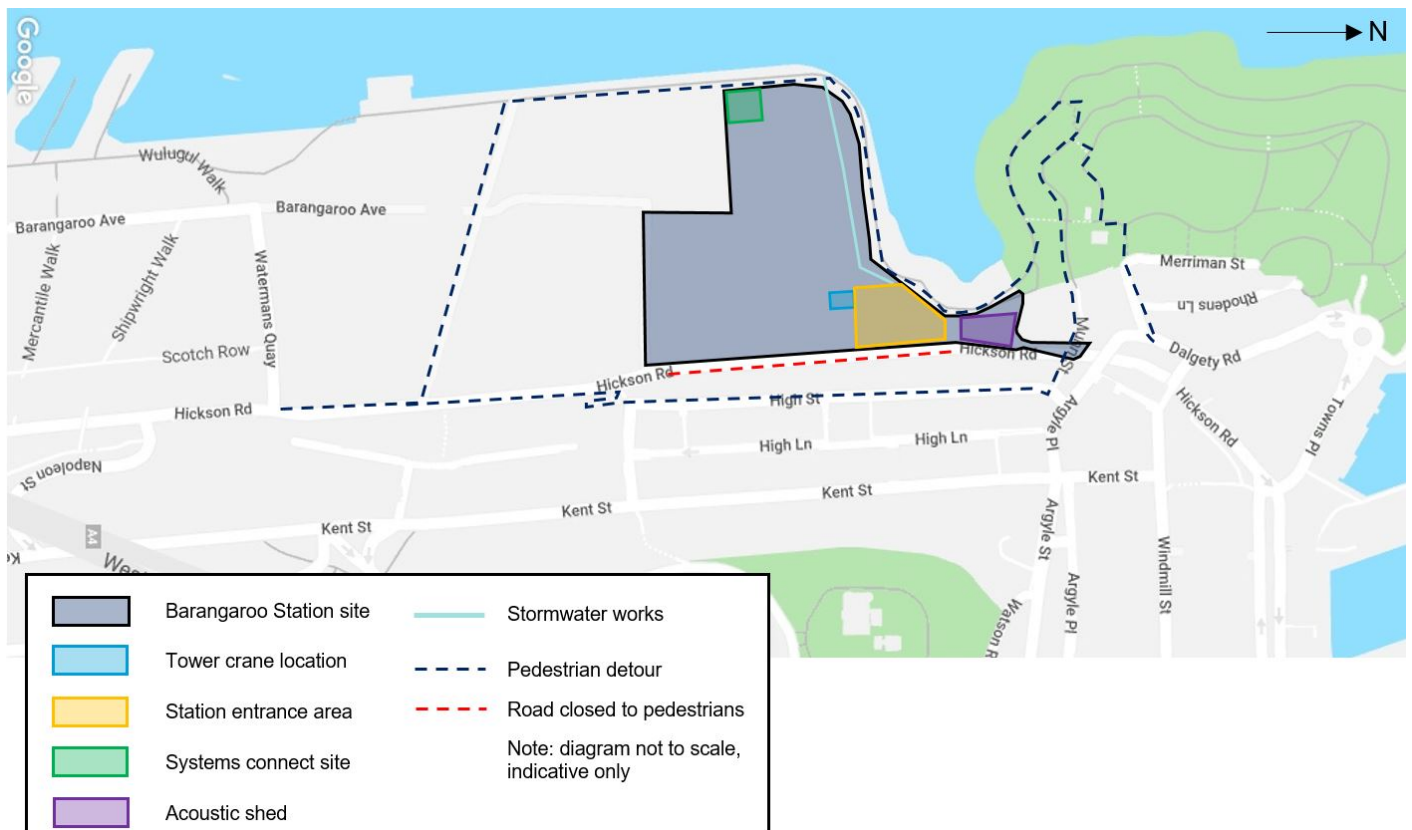
Any out of hours works (OOHW) will be communicated through specific OOHW notifications prior to commencement.

Christmas shutdown

Construction works at Barangaroo Station will be paused between 23 December 2021 and 4 January 2022. During this shutdown you may still see some workers at the site. These workers will be undertaking activities to maintain site safety, including providing 24/7 security, maintaining critical plant and equipment, and conducting environmental inspections.
