

Notification – Bringelly

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.

The railway will service the new airport and airport business park, the Western Sydney Aerotropolis, Luddenham, Orchard Hills and St Marys – here customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All works will be undertaken in line with Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans. We will continue to keep the community updated about any further changes to Sydney Metro construction activities.

Survey investigations: Derwent and Badgerys Creek Roads, Bringelly

Survey work will be carried out to assist with the planning and design of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

Work is expected to start from **Tuesday 11 January 2022 and will continue for up to four weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting and pending NSW Public Health Advice.

Work will include:

- Non-intrusive surveys along Derwent and Badgerys Creek Roads
- Traffic cones placed around survey equipment in public areas

What to expect:

- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- There will be no disruption to traffic or pedestrians

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to: survey equipment, traffic cones and light vehicles.

Demolition work: Derwent Road, Bringelly

Demolition work will be carried out at 40 Derwent Road, Bringelly to prepare for the construction of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

Work is expected to start from **Thursday 20 January 2022 and will continue for up to five weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting and pending NSW Public Health Advice.

Work will include:

- Establishing a temporary site compound at 40 Derwent Road, Bringelly
- Disconnecting utility services from the site
- Tree and vegetation removal
- Demolishing buildings and structures

- Safely removing hazardous and building materials from the site

What to expect:

- Work will generate some noise during construction hours and our team will minimise impacts where possible
- Work will generate dust and our team will minimise this by using water trucks where possible
- Hazardous material will be appropriately covered and safely removed from the site
- An increase in vehicle movements on Derwent Road, entering and exiting the site
- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- There will be no disruption to utility services

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to: a boom lift, trucks, including a water truck, excavator, chainsaw, wood chipper and skip bins.

Work hours:

All work will be completed during standard construction hours of Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday and Sunday 7am to 6pm.

Residents and businesses will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work.

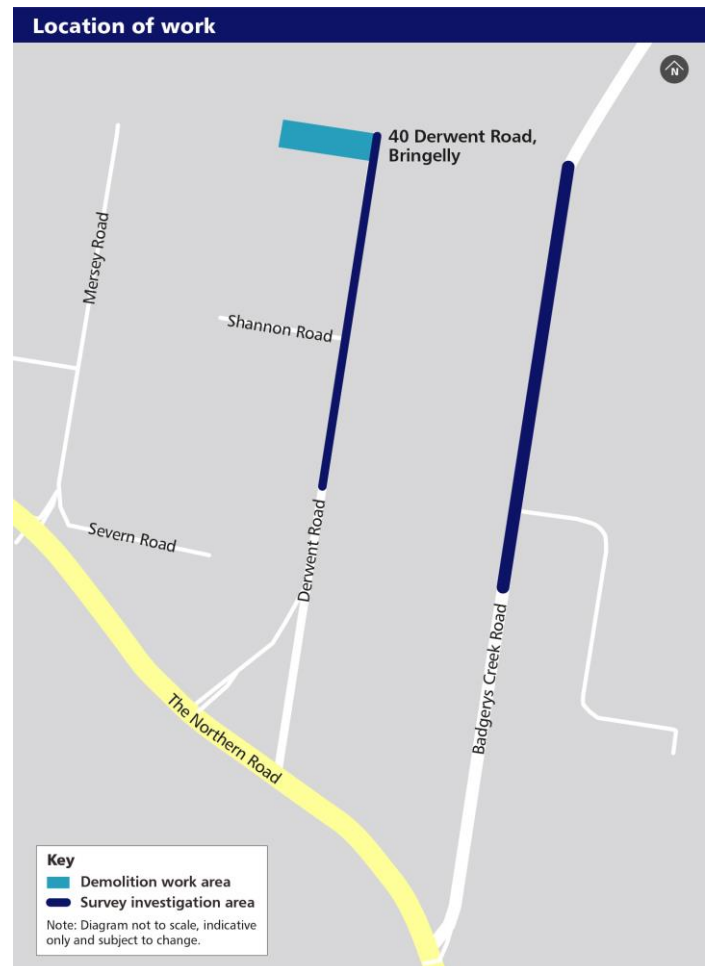
