

Notification – Clyde and surrounds

21 December 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Construction work at Clyde

Construction work at the future Clyde stabling and maintenance facility site and surrounding areas will be ongoing throughout January. Please see the map overleaf for the work locations.

Our standard construction hours are **Mondays to Fridays 7am to 6pm** and **Saturdays from 8am to 6pm**

There will be no work during the holiday period between 23 December and 9 January. During this time, there will be workers in and around the site providing 24/7 security, conducting site inspections, and maintaining machinery and equipment. **Works will re-commence from Monday 10 January.**

All works will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans.

Out-of-hours work

Survey work on Parramatta Road and Rawson Street previously notified for early December has been rescheduled due to wet weather. The work will now start on **Sunday 16 January and will continue for up to two weeks, Sunday to Friday between 7pm and 5am.**

Transportation of a large excavator off site is expected to occur during the **week commencing 3 January between midnight and 4am**, in line with Transport for NSW requirements for the movement of oversized vehicles.


Work during standard construction hours will include:

- Property strip out activities and partially removing buildings
- Installing scaffolding and hoarding and demolishing buildings
- Temporary traffic lane closures to facilitate exclusion zones during demolition work
- Removing materials from site, including hazardous waste
- Delivery and removal of machinery, equipment, and materials to and from site
- Using truck mounted drill rigs to bore below ground for geotechnical investigations
- Non-intrusive drainage and topographical survey work, including opening and inspecting pits
- Removing redundant utilities, including gas and electrical services
- Excavating trenches to locate existing underground infrastructure and install new infrastructure, as required
- Backfilling and reinstating areas impacted by site establishment work.

What to expect:

- Some activities will generate noise, but this will be minimised as much as possible
- Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- Traffic management and signage may be used to ensure the safety of our workers and the community.
