

Notification - The Bays, Rozelle

4 January 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations.

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All work will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans.

Out-of-hours work at The Bays Station site

The tunnelling contractor, AFJV, is undertaking utility relocation work within The Bays Station site to prepare for major construction. Due to the location of work along Port Access Road this work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Night work will be carried out on **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday nights between 6pm and 6am from Tuesday 11 January 2022 until Friday 25 February 2022** (weather and site conditions permitting).

The work will include:

- Site set up and locating of services prior to start of excavation
- Saw cutting surface material (concrete/bitumen) to open the work trench
- Excavation of material and removal of spoil
- Laying and installing high voltage electrical conduit
- Backfilling, compacting and sealing of trenches

What to expect:

- Noise blankets will be used where possible to minimise disturbance
- Noise monitoring will be utilised during the work to confirm predicted noise levels at nearest residences
- There will be no disruption to the supply of utility services to residences

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: concrete saws, excavators, tipper truck, vacuum truck, plate compactor, light vehicles, light tower and electric hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

All work will be carried out within The Bays construction site, so there will be no changes to public traffic, pedestrian or cycle routes. Internal traffic management measures will be in place for site traffic safety on Port Access Road.
