

## Notification – Westmead

9 December 2021

### Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

### Telstra works: Westmead (Out-of-hours)

Telstra will be undertaking network remediation work for the Sydney Metro West project along Alexandra Avenue. Work is expected to commence on **Monday 13 December 2021 for up to five days**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Due to traffic volumes on Alexandra Avenue and to minimise impacts on essential transport routes this work will be done outside of standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 8pm to 5am**.

The safety of the community and our workforce is top priority. All works will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using COVID-safe measures and plans.

#### Work will involve:

- Establishing a temporary site
- Removal of concrete and asphalt with bob-saw
- Installing conduit with pits
- Removing soil from site using a vacuum excavation truck
- Reinstating the area at completion of the work.

#### What to expect:

- This work will generate some noise and Telstra will minimise impacts where possible
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for safety of workers and the community
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- There will be no disruption to delivery of network services.

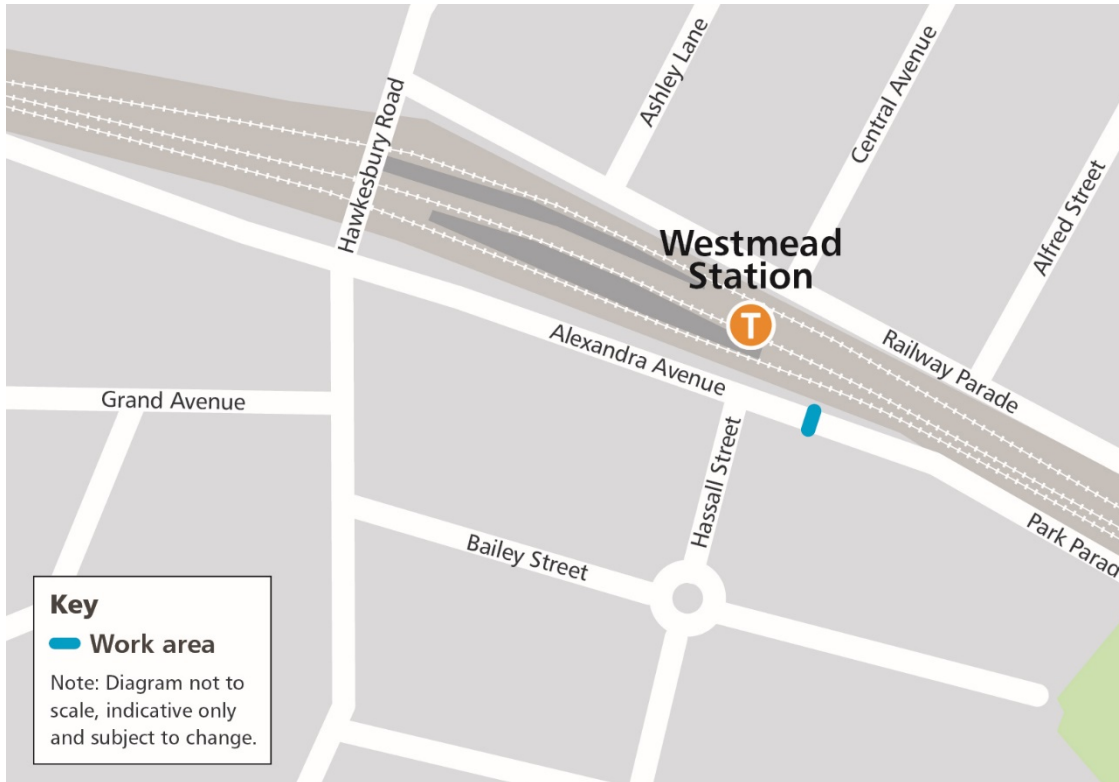
#### Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: bob-saws, vacuum trucks, hand tools, temporary fencing, light vehicles and generators.

### Changes to traffic pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic controls, or partial road closures.
