

January notification – Westmead

21 December 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Construction work at Westmead

Construction work at the Westmead metro station site and site investigations in the surrounding area will continue throughout January 2022. This work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday and Sunday 8am to 6pm** (if required).

There will be no work during the holiday period from 23 December 2021 – work will resume on 10 January 2022. Workers will be conducting security checks and inspections during this time.

All work will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using COVID safe measures and plans.

Work will involve:

- Installation of hoarding and scaffold
- Site and vegetation clearing
- Disconnection of utility services
- Building strip out including removal of awnings
- Relocation of site amenities
- Delivery of materials to site including machinery and equipment
- Small to large truck movements to and from site.
- Removal of materials from site including demolition waste, building and hazardous materials
- Structural demolition of buildings.

What to expect:

- This work will generate some noise and the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Increased vehicle movements to and from site
- Delivery vehicles will access site via Alexandra Avenue, Bailey and Hassall Street
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for safety of workers and the community
- Environmental measure will be in place to mitigate construction impacts including noise and vibration monitoring and dust suppression
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: bobcats, excavators, bin trucks, scissor lifts, skid steer and hand tools.

Changes to traffic pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic controls, or partial road closures.

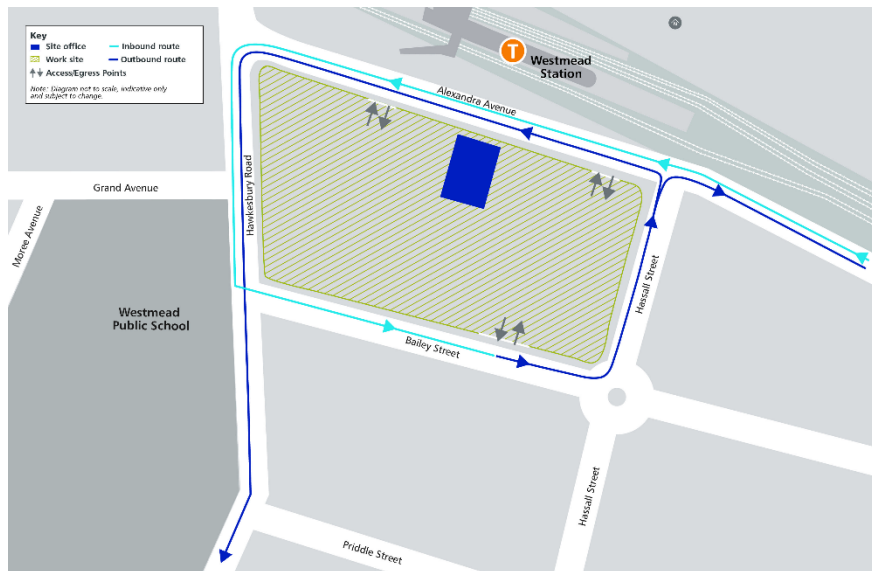
Out of hours work:

Equipment delivery is expected outside standard construction hours in line with Transport for NSW requirements for the movement of oversized vehicles. This delivery will be completed **between Tuesday 11 January 2022 and Friday 14 January 2022 10pm to 5am.**

Transport for NSW is undertaking enabling work within the rail corridor at Westmead Station to prepare the site for the construction of Sydney Metro. This work has been scheduled to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods where trains are not running, minimising disruptions to commuter. Work will be carried **out between 6pm Thursday 13 until 2am Monday 17 January 2022.**


Businesses and residents nearby to these works will be notified in advance of out-of-hours work.
