

Notification – Barangaroo Station

30 June 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66-kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland CPB Ghella (JHCPBG) is building the 15.5-kilometre long twin railway tunnels between Chatswood and Sydenham and excavating six new metro stations, including one at Barangaroo.

Upcoming out-of-hours work - Hickson Road

From Friday 9 July 2021 there will be up to three nights of out-of-hours work on Hickson Road. This is to allow for inspections, maintenance, and additional work that is required on the Hickson Road bridge.

Due to high daytime traffic volumes, the nature of activities and to ensure pedestrian safety, **this work will be carried out at night between 10pm and 5am.**

During this work Hickson Road will be closed between Towns Place and Watermans Quay and road users may experience short delays.

A detour will be in place via Towns Place, Dalgety Road, Kent Street and Napoleon Street. Bus services 311, 324 and 325 will be rerouted via this detour. There will be some changes to bus stops, including temporary bus stops near the corner of Kent Street and High Street. These bus stops will service the 311, 324 and 325 bus services. Directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community. Please refer to the map over the page for details about the road closure, detour route and changes to bus services.

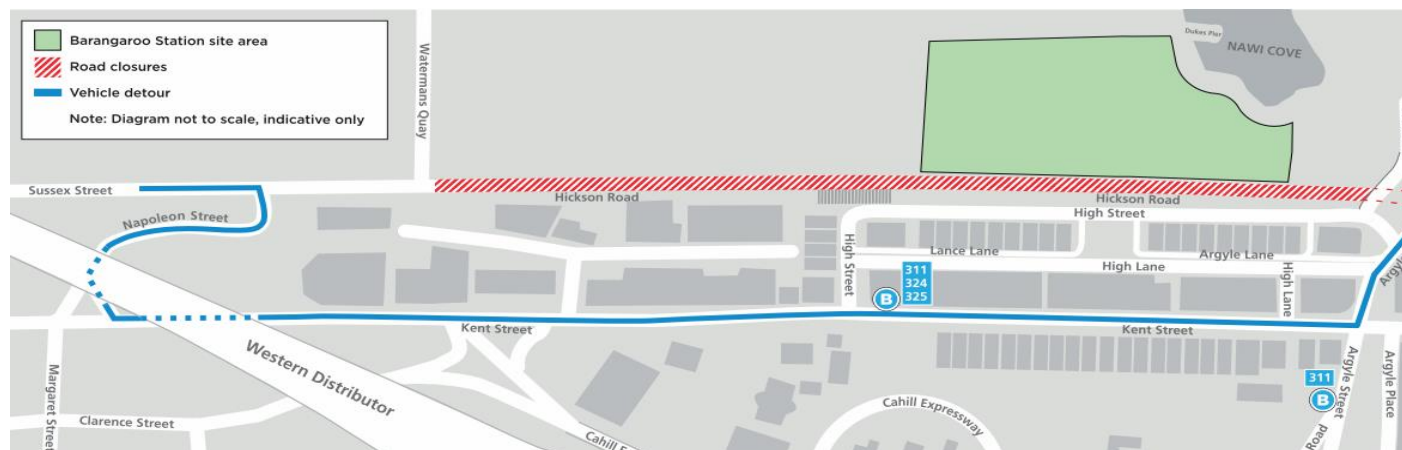

What to expect

- Temporary lighting may be used to ensure a safe work site and will be directed away from properties.
- There will be traffic management onsite to aid pedestrians and direct traffic.
- Equipment to be used includes hydraulic pumps, elevated work platforms and hand tools.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times to and from the foreshore from the south and to High Steps, Nawi Cove and Barangaroo Reserve.
- Access to driveways along Hickson Road will be maintained for residents and businesses.
