

Notification – Burwood North

13 January 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Acciona Ferrovia Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including Burwood North Station.

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All work will be undertaken in line with NSW Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans.

Out-of-hours work around Burwood North Station site

The tunnelling contractor, AFJV, is undertaking awning removal work around the southern Burwood North station site to prepare for the start of major construction.

Awning removal work along Burwood Road and Parramatta Road must be undertaken outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Night work will be carried out **between 8pm and 5am on Thursday 20, Friday 21, Monday 24 and Tuesday 25 January 2022** (weather and site conditions permitting).

The work will include:

- Removal of existing shop awnings that overhang the footpath using elevated work platforms and demolition shears

What to expect:

- There will be some noise associated with this work but we will minimise this as much as possible
- Where possible, noise blankets will be used to minimise disturbance
- Traffic controls will be in place to manage traffic and pedestrian access
- Property access will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: elevated work platforms, bobcats, bin truck, light vehicles, angle grinder, excavator with shear attachment, Hiab truck, lighting towers, circular saws, impact drivers and hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including partial road and footpath closures on Parramatta Road and Burwood Road.
