

## Project update

March 2022

### Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, commercial building above and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

### Upcoming work – Victoria Cross Station sites

Below is an indicative table of activities scheduled at the two Victoria Cross Station sites in March.

Victoria Cross Station South site	<p>Work may include but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• detailed excavation works including saw cutting rock and jackhammering</li> <li>• formwork and steel fixing works</li> <li>• installing scaffolding within the site to create safe access for onsite workers</li> <li>• waterproofing works within site</li> <li>• tower crane and hoist operations</li> <li>• workers accessing tunnels for fit out of cross passages</li> <li>• deliveries received at the Miller, Berry and Denison streets work zones</li> <li>• concrete pouring via concrete pumps within project work zones.</li> </ul>
Miller Street Stormwater works	<p>Stormwater upgrade works will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• establishing work zone in Miller Street</li> <li>• excavation, saw cutting, hammering and hand tools</li> <li>• small vehicles and deliveries</li> <li>• installation of stormwater pits and pipes in Miller Street.</li> </ul>

### What to expect

- Equipment used will include concrete pumps, elevated working platforms, mobile cranes, tower cranes, trucks, handheld drills and light vehicles.
- Traffic and pedestrian changes to Denison, Miller and surrounding streets. Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts where possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.

Monday to Friday nights, 1 March to 31 March, 6pm to 10pm	North site	Work involves: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>concrete delivery and pumping from the north yard, and placement within the north shaft</li> <li>delivery of materials</li> <li>formwork preparation and steel fixing within the north shaft</li> <li>services installation within the north shaft</li> <li>waterproofing and scaffold alterations within the north shaft.</li> </ul>

Thursday 24 March, 9pm to 5am *Subject to further approvals	McLaren and Miller streets	Work involves: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>removal of the Ausgrid terminal on the corner of McLaren and Miller streets</li> <li>traffic diversion on McLaren Street.</li> </ul>

### Extended work hours:

Lendlease have been implementing extended working hours at both Victoria Cross sites from 7am to 6pm on Saturdays and Sundays under NSW Government Covid-19 orders. During the extended hours on Saturday 7am to 8am and 1pm to 6pm, and Sunday 7am to 6pm, there will be no high noise activities such as rock breaking, rock hammering, sheet piling and pile driving occurring. These extended working hours are expected to continue, which will be subject to further assessment and approvals.



## Systems Connect work at Victoria Cross Station

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work including installing metro rail track, power systems and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

Systems Connect will be accessing the tunnels through Victoria Cross Station sites and will be delivering and pouring concrete via the North site, receiving deliveries, installing electrical equipment, cable containment works and placing pre-cast track slabs in the tunnels. These works will take place in line with the Victoria Cross Station hours of operation.
