

## Project update – Barangaroo Station

March 2022

### Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66-kilometre standalone metro railway system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

BESIX Watpac has been awarded the contract to build Barangaroo Station. BESIX Watpac will deliver the station fit-out and associated landscaping and civil works, including the re-alignment of Hickson Road.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work which includes installing metro rail track, power systems, communications and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

### Barangaroo Station – upcoming work

In March, the BESIX Watpac team will focus on continuing station fit-out works and preparation for a traffic switch on Hickson Road next month. Relocation of Hickson Road approximately 15 metres west (towards the water) is required to enable essential service work and stormwater drainage under the existing road.

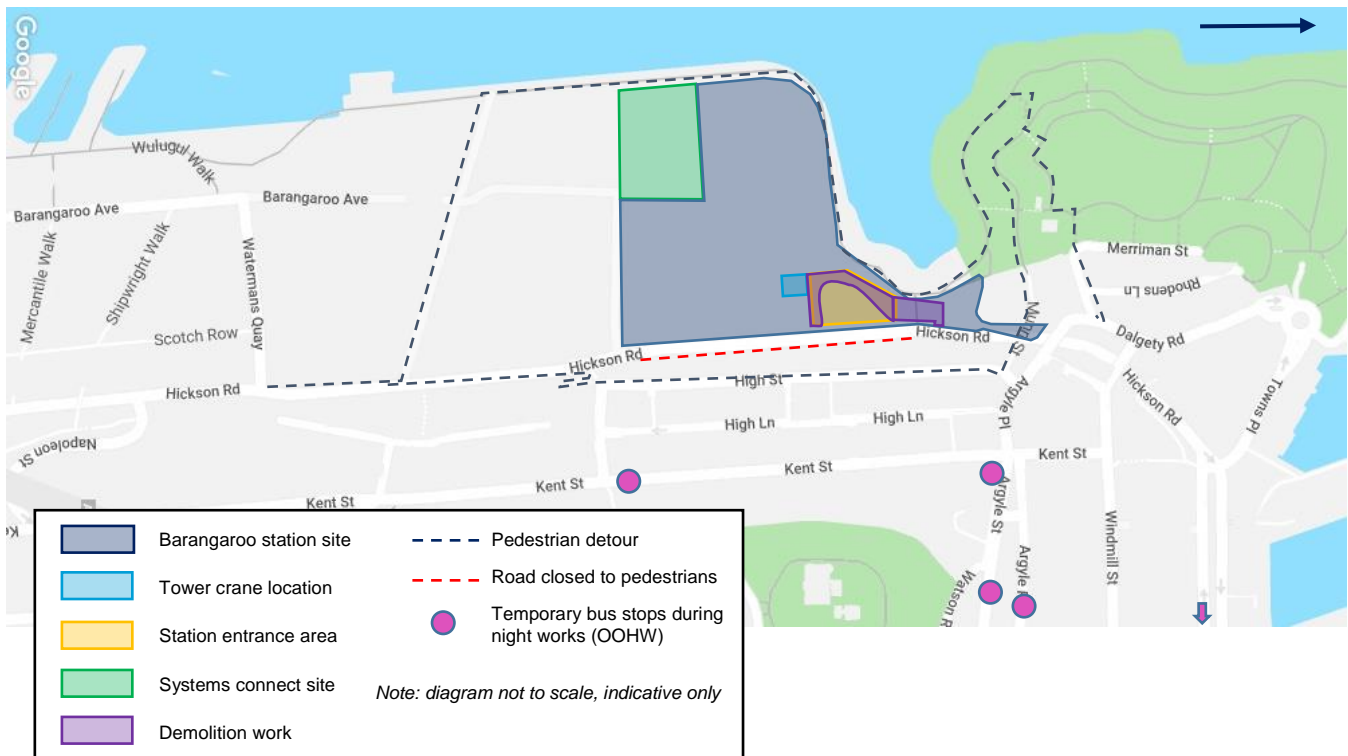
Systems Connect will continue with tunnel fit-out, temporary services installation and delivering plant, material, and equipment to the station site. There will be some high impact noise works at the end of March 2022. Systems Connect will consult with all affected residents directly.

The following table provides more information about the activities planned for March 2022. All activities are weather and site conditions permitting.

## Out of hours works

Standard working hours on the Barangaroo station project are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Some of the planned work to realign Hickson Road will need to take place out-of-hours to minimise impact to road users. BESIX Watpac will send specific Out of Hours Works (OOHW) notifications to inform the community of the upcoming works and how noise will be managed.

The planned out-of-hours works dates in March are:

- 6:00pm Sunday 27 February – 5am Friday 4 March
- 6:00pm Sunday 6 March – 5am Friday 11 March
- 6:00pm Sunday 13 March – 5am Friday 18 March
- 6:00pm Sunday 20 March – 5am Friday 25 March

During these periodic night works, there will be occasions when Hickson Road will be closed between Towns Place and Barton Street, and road users may experience short delays. During any road closures, a traffic detour will be in place via Towns Place, Dalgety Road, Kent Street and Napoleon Street. Bus services 311, 324 and 325 will be rerouted via this detour.
