Monthly Update - Sydenham Station

April 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

John Holland Pty Ltd and Laing O'Rourke Australia Construction Pty Ltd have been awarded the contract for major railway work at Sydenham as part of Sydney Metro, including the upgrade of Sydenham Station.

The new pedestrian concourse, connecting the two new plaza entrances to the station on Railway Parade and Burrows Avenue, will open to the public in the near future. Local residents will continue to receive updates in the leadup to the opening.

In April work will continue to upgrade Sydenham Station (weather and site conditions permitting). Access to the work sites will be via existing access gates. Day work can currently be undertaken Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday and Sunday 7am-6pm in accordance with *Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order (No. 2) 2021.*

All work activities are subject to relevant approvals.

Upcoming work

Work to upgrade Sydenham Station to metro standards is underway with work zones set up on Sydenham Station Platforms 4, 5 and 6, as well as Sydenham Road, Burrows Avenue, Railway Parade, Bedwin Road bridge and Edgeware Road.

Standard work hours

The following activities will be undertaken during standard construction hours (details above).


- Installation of station signs
- Tiling work throughout the station
- Installation of platform doors
- Commissioning work of the new Southern Plaza and access onto platforms 3,4 and 6 via the new Sydney Metro concourse
- Minor fencing work along the rail corridor
- Grouting of platform
- Survey works along the rail corridor and at the station
- PBE installation on platforms 1 and 2
- Installation of speakers, cameras and other communication equipment (including public areas)
- Fitout of communications rooms
- Installation of signalling equipment
- Cable hauling along trackway
- Testing and commission work
- Security fencing installation work along Edgeware Road
 - \circ $\;$ Periodic lane closures and pedestrian diversions will be in place
- Removal of water barriers along Bolton Street and Burrows Avenue
 - o Periodic lane closures and pedestrian diversions will be in place

What to expect

- Workers will access the rail corridor via designated rail access gates at Railway Parade (Bedwin Road bridge), Railway Road, Burrows Avenue, and Sydenham Road intersection with Railway Parade.
- During delivery of plant and material, periodic removal of up to six parking spaces may be required alongside above-mentioned rail access gates. Signage will be installed to notify motorists.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- Oversized equipment will be delivered to work areas.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
- Watercarts will be used to manage dust.
- Some work will be noisy. Equipment is fitted with non-tonal reverse beepers, that will be switched off when not in use.
- Equipment will include lighting towers, trucks, excavators.
- Lights from lighting towers will be directed away from residential properties when in use.
