

Notification – Claremont Meadows

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.

The railway will service the new airport and airport business park, the Western Sydney Aerotropolis, Luddenham, Orchard Hills and St Marys – here customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

The Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project has received planning approval from both the Australian and NSW Governments and construction started in 2020. Major construction, including station excavation, is set to start in late 2022.

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All works will be undertaken in line with Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans. We will continue to keep the community updated about any further changes to Sydney Metro construction activities.

Out-of-hours work: Great Western Highway and Gipps Street, Claremont Meadows

Power supply works at Claremont Meadows began in mid-February 2022 and will be completed in the coming weeks. Quickway has been awarded the contract to install dedicated power supply routes from nearby existing substations or overhead cables to newly installed power kiosks at Sydney Metro construction sites.

Work outside standard construction hours is required on Great Western Highway and Gipps Street, from **6pm Thursday 28 April to 7am Friday 29 April 2022**, weather and site conditions permitting and pending NSW Public Health Advice. Work is carried out at night, to mitigate unacceptable risks to safety and traffic flow

Work will include:


- Installing new overhead cables across Great Western Highway and near the intersection of Great Western Highway and Gipps Street
- Restrunging and relocating existing cables across Great Western Highway and Gipps Street
- Installing power poles on Great Western Highway
- Using the site compound at 1 – 17 Gipps Street to store equipment and material for the work
- Reinstating work areas at completion of the work.

What to expect:

- Work will generate occasional noise and our team will minimise impacts, where possible. This includes but is not limited to carrying out noisier works earlier in the night, using low noise equipment and non-tonal reverse alarms, limiting compression braking by trucks, switching equipment off when not in use and monitoring noise levels
- Light towers will be used and positioned away from residents
- There will be some traffic disruptions to ensure the safety of work crews while carrying out the work
- Increased vehicle movements on surrounding roads
- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- There will be no disruption to the delivery of utility services.

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to: elevated work platforms, tipper and water trucks, excavators, light towers, cranes, cable trailers, cable installation equipment and light vehicles.



Changes to traffic and pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic controls, or partial road closures. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.
