

# Notification – Central Station

20 April 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

## Rescheduled work at 20-28 Chalmers Street, Surry Hills

On **Thursday 28 April 2022**, Sydney Metro will undertake a concrete pour of the roof slab at the new entrance on Chalmers Street. Due to the nature of the work, and strict sequencing of associated activities, we expect the concrete pour to extend outside standard working hours, and continue **overnight on Friday 29 April**, as described below.

- The work activities during the day (**6am – 8pm**) will include the concrete pour and concrete truck movements.
- The work activities at night (**8pm – 7am**) will include concrete finishing work.

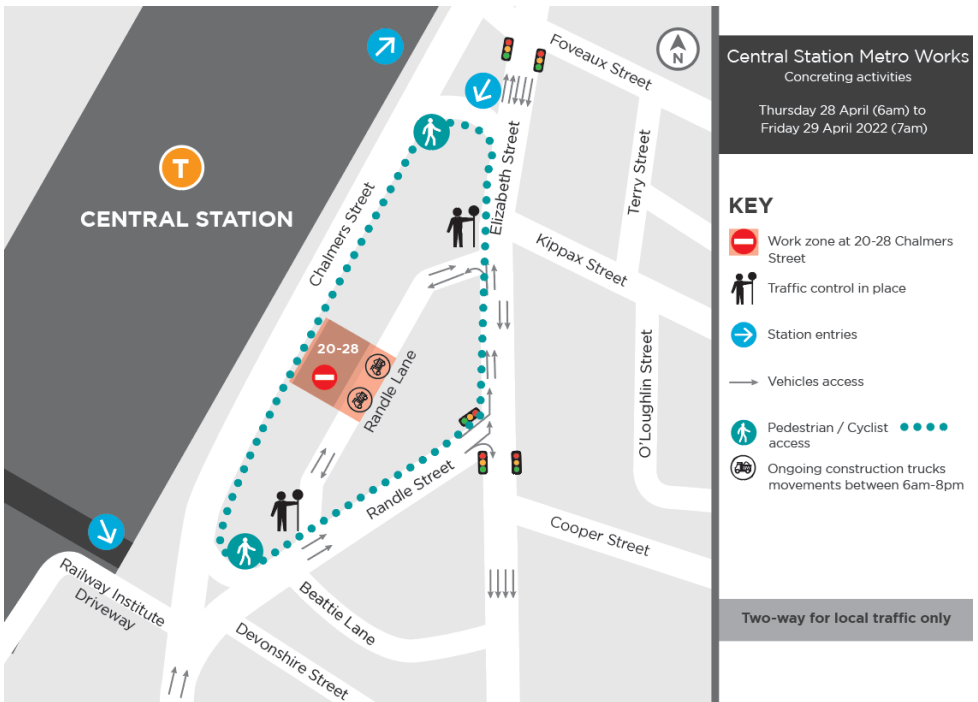
### What to expect

- Access to private car parks and emergency exits onto Randle Lane will be maintained at all times. Rubbish collection will operate as usual.
- Access through Randle Lane will be maintained at all times. Delays may be experienced at times; however, the team will make every effort to facilitate access in a timely manner.
- Ongoing construction vehicle movements should be expected in and around Randle Lane (see [map overleaf](#)).
- Machinery used during the work will include concrete trucks, mechanical trowel, construction vehicles and trucks along with hand and power tools.
- During the works, traffic control will be located in Randle Lane to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users around the work area.

- Due to the nature of the work, some of the associated activities may be noisy at times during the day. High-impact noise and vibration activities are only permitted between the hours of **8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday** and from **8am until 1pm on Saturday**. A one-hour respite period will be provided every three hours during highly noise intensive work.
- This work is highly weather-dependant and may be postponed due to inclement weather. If this is the case, another community notification will be distributed, with a new work date (weather permitting).
