

## Monthly update – The Bays, Rozelle

May 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at The Bays.

### Site establishment work: The Bays Station site

Site establishment work will continue within The Bays Station site throughout May. The main activities will include utility relocation work, piling work for the station box, concreting work and building internal access roads.

Unless otherwise stated below or notified separately, this work will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 6pm

### Ongoing work includes:

- Utility work, including night work along the Port Access Road which has been notified separately
- Ground improvement work at White Bay Power Station
- Site levelling and excavation
- Construction of internal roads and retaining walls
- Concrete work within the site
- Piling work for the station box and acoustic shed (this activity will continue to be carried out until 9pm on weeknights)
- Installation of new fencing, hoarding and site offices
- Geotechnical investigation work around the White Bay Power Station

### New work starting in May includes:

- Installation of ground anchors for the station box walls
- Water treatment plant establishment
- Commencement of acoustic sheds and gantry beam construction
- Delivery and set up of site offices

### What to expect:

- There may be some noise associated with the work but we will try to minimise this as much as possible
- Strict safety and environmental controls will be in place for all work
- Vehicles will be parked within the construction site

### Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: trucks, light vehicles, excavators, graders, watercarts, telehandlers, vacuum trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, hand tools, piling and drill rigs.

### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions during the night work including stop-slow traffic controls, partial road and footpath closures. Internal traffic management measures will be in place for work within The Bays construction site.
