

Notification - The Bays, Rozelle

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations.

Out-of-hours work – revised dates

The tunnelling contractor, AFJV, is undertaking utility relocation work within The Bays Station site. This work must occur outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on Port Access Road traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists and workers.

Due to wet weather and ground conditions, the previously notified utility relocation night work within The Bays construction site will continue on **Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday nights from Friday 13 May to Friday 03 June 2022 between 6pm and 6am** (weather and site conditions permitting).

The utility relocation work at The Bays Station site will include:

- Saw cutting surface material (concrete/bitumen) to open the trench
- Excavation and removal of material
- Installation of new sewer pipes
- Backfilling, compacting and sealing of trenches

What to expect:

- There will be no disruption to the supply of utility services to residences
- Some activities will generate noise but this will be minimised as much as possible and noise monitoring will be undertaken
- Two-way traffic will be maintained on Port Access Road at all times

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: concrete saws, excavators with bucket or hammer attachments, tipper truck, vacuum truck, plate compactor, light vehicles, light towers and electric hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including partial road closures along the Port Access Road. Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times.
