

Notification – Claremont Meadows and Orchard Hills

20 May 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.

The railway will service the new airport and airport business park, the Western Sydney Aerotropolis, Luddenham, Orchard Hills and St Marys – here customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

The Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project has received planning approval from both the Australian and NSW Governments and construction started in 2020. Major construction, including station excavation, is set to start in late 2022.

The safety of the community and our workforce is our top priority. All works will be undertaken in line with Public Health Orders, using a range of COVID-safe measures and plans. We will continue to keep the community updated about any further changes to Sydney Metro construction activities.

Out-of-hours work: Power supply works - M4 Motorway and Caddens Road

Power supply works at Claremont Meadows began in mid-February 2022 and will be completed in the coming weeks. Quickway has been awarded the contract to install dedicated power supply routes from nearby existing substations or overhead cables to newly installed power kiosks at Sydney Metro construction sites.

Power supply works will be undertaken from Caddens Road to under the M4 Motorway and will include under boring, as required, to install new conduits and cables to supply power to the kiosk at 70 – 74 Kent Road, Orchard Hills.

Work outside standard construction hours is required and is expected to start from **Friday, 20 May, and continue for up to four weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting and pending NSW Public Health Advice.

M4 Motorway works activities:

These works will be completed outside standard construction hours **Monday to Sunday 6pm to 7am**. Work is being carried out at night, including weekends, to mitigate unacceptable risks to safety or traffic flow.

Caddens Road works activities:

Work will be completed outside standard construction hours **Saturday to Sunday 6am to 6pm**. Work is being carried out **during the day over two weekends**, to mitigate unacceptable risks to safety or traffic flow.

Work will include:

- Excavation works for conduit trenching
- Under bore works using excavation equipment between Caddens Road and under the M4 Motorway from South to North Kent Road, to install conduits
- Backfilling pits and reinstating work areas at completion of work.

What to expect:

- There will be some noise associated with these works. We will try to minimise this as much as possible
- Noisier works will be carried out earlier in the night, use low noise equipment and non-tonal reverse alarms, limiting compression braking by trucks, switching equipment off when not in use and monitoring noise levels
- Increased vehicle movements on surrounding roads
- Access to driveways and buildings will be always maintained
- There will be no disruption to utility services.

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to: excavators, trucks including delivery, vacuum and water trucks, cranes, under boring equipment cable trailers, and light vehicles.



Changes to traffic and pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow, stop-slow traffic controls, or partial road closures. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.
