

Notification – Construction update

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021. This includes the construction of a new power supply route from Rozelle substation to the future metro station at The Bays. New cables will be laid underground to provide a dedicated power supply source to the Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) for Sydney Metro West.

The contract for the Iron Cove/Rozelle power supply route has been awarded to Quickway.

Site compound within the Port Authority of NSW site

Work on the Iron Cove/Rozelle power supply route is continuing to progress well.

As part of our work to finish the last section of conduits, we will be establishing a site compound within the Port Authority of NSW site at Rozelle. Please see the map over the page outlining the location of this compound.

We will start work to establish the compound from Saturday 21 May 2022. We expect to use this compound for up to four months. We will use the compound to store equipment, containers and materials. The compound will be accessed at various times both during standard construction hours and out-of-hours. We will access the compound via Port Access Road and Robert Street.

Following the completion of our work to install the new new power supply, the compound will be removed.

Work will involve:

- Establishing a compound area
- Using the area for storage of equipment, containers and materials
- Access to and operations at the site compound at various times both during standard construction hours and out-of-hours
- When our work is finished, restoration of the area.


What to expect

- Construction machinery and equipment operating inside the designated compound
- Trucks and construction machinery such as excavators operating in the compound
- Increased heavy and light vehicle movements in the area
- The work may generate some noise, the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Lighting will be used during the out of hours work.

Equipment used

The equipment used will include but not be limited to excavators, tippers and heavy and light vehicles.
