

Notification – Westmead

24 June 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont, and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Transport for Tomorrow (T4T) has been awarded the contract to undertake enabling work at the existing Westmead Station to prepare the site for construction of Sydney Metro. This work primarily involves the relocation of existing services within the rail corridor.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver the Western Tunnelling Package which involves nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Construction work at Westmead - July

Day work will be ongoing within our construction sites and in local streets during standard construction hours: Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm; and Saturday 8am to 6pm.

Out-of-hours works will occur from 6pm on Friday 1 July to 7am on Monday 4 July 2022 during scheduled Sydney Trains track work weekends and when trains are not running to minimise or avoid disruption to commuter services and / or road traffic. Details on upcoming works are outlined on the following page.

Transport for Tomorrow work

- Site investigation work to locate underground services
- Excavation for footings and protective steel troughing within the rail corridor
- Construction of a debris wall within the rail corridor
- Cable containment on the station platform
- Cable pulling and rail signalling work
- Trenching work for installation of buried cable routes
- Installing services into the canopy at Westmead Station
- Installation and removal of poles and conductors
- Vegetation and spoil removal.


- Surveying local roads and nearby streets to record their existing condition
- Conducting geotechnical investigations to assess ground conditions and to monitor groundwater
- Conducting utility investigations such as potholing and relocation of services such as power, gas and water
- Preparing for site establishment including:
 - Clearing within the work site and installing fencing, hoarding and signage
 - Constructing site access at existing site entry points
 - Installing site amenities, sheds, environmental controls including sediment control fencing.
- Delivering machinery, equipment, mobile cranes and materials to site and removing waste materials including demolition waste, building and hazardous materials.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist routes:

To facilitate access to our work areas and safely operate machinery, **we will temporarily remove access to parking in some sections of Alexandra Avenue in July**. Please see the map overleaf for work locations and areas where parking removal will be required. Access to pathways, properties and Westmead Station will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used for work includes but is not limited to excavators, cranes, semi-trailers, elevated work platforms, concrete trucks, a generator, rock hammers, vacuum truck, hand tools, saws, dump truck, tipper, and light vehicles.

Out-of-hours work over the next three months is detailed in the table below.

Utility service providers will continue routine maintenance works on assets at the Westmead metro site. These works may be conducted out-of-hours as required. Utility service providers will notify impacted stakeholders separately.
