

Notification – Central Station

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown, with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have a network of four metro lines, 46 stations, and 113km of new metro rail.

The new Chalmers Street entrance to Central Station

As part of Sydney Metro Central Station works, a new entrance to the station is being built at 20-28 Chalmers Street. Work is progressing at the site and will now include fit-out activities.


From Monday, 1 August, Chalmers Street site construction working hours will change, and station fit-out work will be permitted 24/7.

What is changing at Chalmers Street site

- Under the conditions of the project's Environmental Protection Licence (EPL) 21148, work for station fit-out is permitted 24/7. For more information, visit www.centralstationmetro.com/documents/
- Construction working hours at the Chalmers Street site will now be allowed 24/7 for station fit-out activities such as installation of electrical, fire, hydraulic, and mechanical services, lifts, escalators, ceiling and wall cladding panels, tiles, louvres, and handrails.
- For station fit-out activities, machinery will include access equipment, small cranes, hand-held power tools, and hand tools
- High-impact noise and vibration activities remain only permitted Monday to Friday (8am-6pm) and Saturday (8am-1pm)
- All feasible measures to keep noise levels to a minimum will continue including 24/7 noise monitoring, installing noise blankets, scheduling noisy works for the daytime, and selecting and using quieter tools.
