

## **Notification – Orchard Hills**

13 July 2022

**Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.**

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23 kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors and United Infrastructure Joint Venture (CPBUI JV) was awarded the surface and civil alignment works contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport in March 2022.

### **Site, geotechnical and contamination investigations: Stabling and Maintenance Facility, Orchard Hills**

Essential site, geotechnical and contamination investigations will be carried out by CPBUI JV and will inform the construction planning and design of the project.

Work is expected to start from **15 July 2022 and will continue for up to six weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Surrounding residents and businesses will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work.

#### **Work will include:**

- Improvements to access point for vehicles
- Non-intrusive site survey works within the private site boundary of the future Stabling and Maintenance Facility site
- Minor vegetation trimming using hand tools
- Drilling with borehole rig and excavation of ground for test pits
- Removing spoil from the work area using a vacuum excavation truck
- Reinstating the work area, once work is complete.

#### **What to expect:**

- There will be no disruption to traffic or pedestrians
- An increase of light vehicles near the work site and surrounding roads
- There will be no disruption to utility services.

#### **Equipment used:**

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to survey equipment including marker pegs and pickets, flagging, hand tools, mobile drill rig, excavator, backhoe, vacuum truck and light vehicles.
