

Notification – St Marys

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23 kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north– where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (CPBGJV) was awarded the tunnelling contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport in December 2021.

Out-of-hours work: Phillip, Lethbridge, and Gidley Streets

Work to relocate utilities is carried out during standard construction hours **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**. To minimise impacts to essential services and traffic some work will also be carried out outside standard construction hours on **Saturday, 16 July 1pm to 4pm** and **Sunday, 17 July 8am to 4pm**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will include:

- Setting up temporary site access and temporary generators
- Excavating a trench across Phillip Street and around base of electricity poles
- Replacing a power pole
- Disconnection and reconnection of utilities

What to expect:

- Some work activities will generate noise. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise these impacts including noise monitoring and respite periods
- Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and traffic safely around work areas
- Increased personnel and vehicle movements in and around the work areas
- Affected residents will be separately notified of interruptions to power supply.

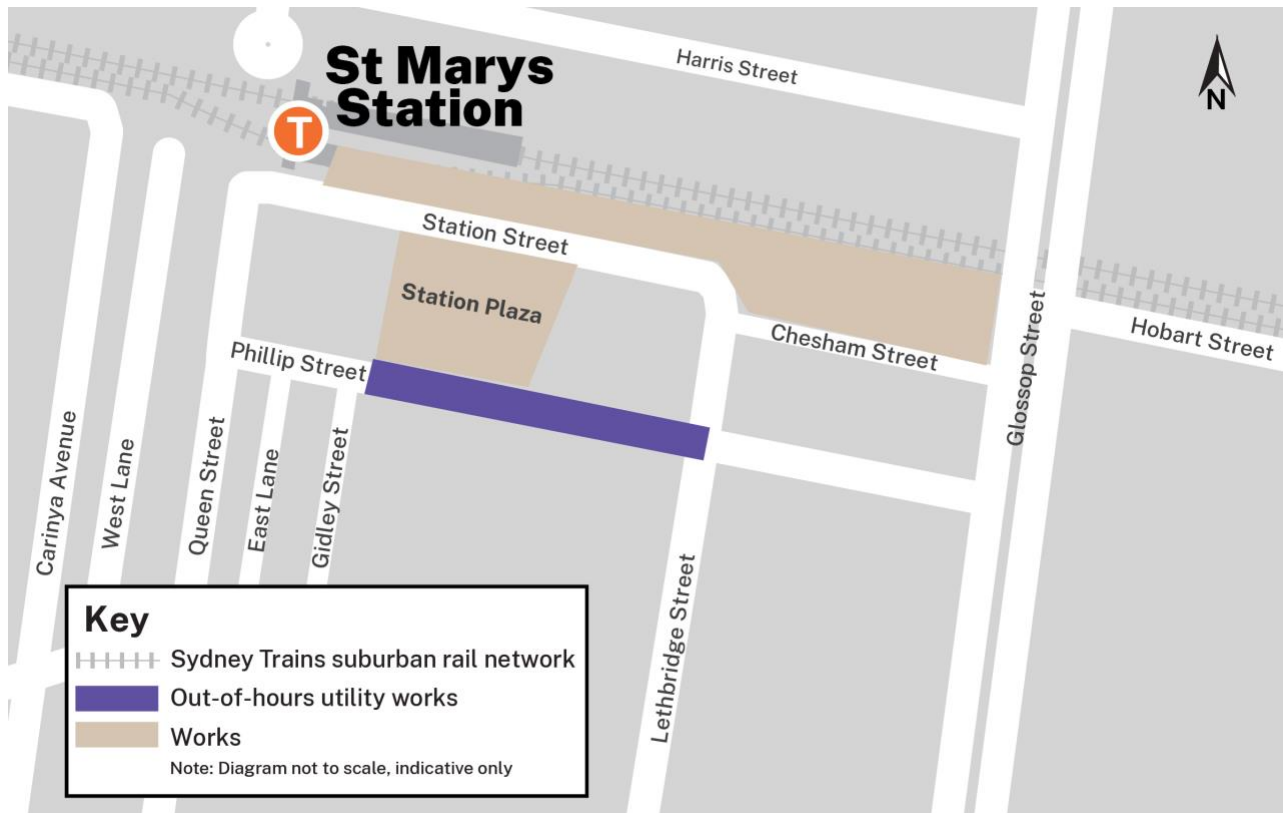
Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to elevated working platform, generators, vacuum trucks, excavators, heavy and light vehicles, traffic management devices and a mobile crane.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow traffic flow and stop-slow traffic controls. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals. Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.
