

Project update

August 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

By 2030, Sydney will have four metro lines, with 46 stations and a 113 kilometre standalone metro rail system. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, commercial building above and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

Stormwater upgrade works on Denison Street

The stormwater system located under Denison Street requires upgrading to support the new Victoria Cross metro station and surrounding community. The final connection to the stormwater can now take place. The below outlines the final stage of works.

To facilitate stormwater upgrade works, Denison Street will be a no through road with two-way traffic flows and access via Berry Street.

Denison Street will be open to local traffic only with access via Berry Street. Please see overleaf for all traffic changes.



From 10 August 2022	Denison Street	<p>Traffic changes put into effect:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Denison Street, with only 105 Miller Street building access via Spring Street • Denison Street north changes to two-way traffic flows with access via Berry Street • Spring Street and Little Spring Street to exit via Mount Street • concrete barriers installed for pedestrian safety • existing signage to be relocated and updated • removal of six parking spaces on the eastern side of Denison Street.
10 August to 31 October 2022		<p>During this period the Denison Street stormwater upgrade works will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • excavation, saw cutting, hammering and hand tools • light vehicles and deliveries • installation of final stormwater pipes in Denison Street.

What to expect

- Standard work hours for this work are **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 6pm.**
- Clear signage advising vehicle access diversions in place.
- Changes to street parking arrangements throughout the works.
- Mobilisation and use of mobile cranes and heavy vehicles.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used, and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Traffic control and pedestrian signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.


