

Notification – Airport Business Park and Terminal

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23 kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors Ghella, was awarded the tunnelling contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport in December 2021.

Construction Update

As part of the Station Boxes and Tunnelling package of Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport, work has commenced at the station sites at the Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport.

Work hours:

Standard construction hours are **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. However, some out-of-hours works will be required.

Current construction activities include:

- Establishing the site with general activities such as maintenance, installing fencing and signage
- Construction of site offices, amenities, and carparks
- Setting up environmental controls, clearing vegetation and conducting site investigations
- Construction of internal access roads involving excavation, earthworks, drainage construction and new road pavement.

Upcoming construction activities:

- Earthworks, piling works and excavation of portal, station box and tunnel shaft structure
- Construction of a water treatment plant and sediment basin, including using a crane to mobilise the plant
- Establishment of excavated materials storage area
- Delivery of excavated materials
- Removal of hazardous material

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to barriers, drill rig, mobile cranes, excavators, mulcher, concrete agitators, articulated dump trucks, concrete pumps and trucks, tippers, bin trucks, vacuum trucks and truck and dogs, powered hand tools, traffic control, bollards, utility scanning and survey equipment and light vehicles.

What to expect:

The newly constructed roundabout at Badgerys Creek Road and Pitt Street Bringelly will be the airport site entry and exit for construction vehicles. We understand construction activities may cause disruption to the nearby community, and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

Haulage and deliveries:

Excavated materials from other tunnelling sites will be delivered to a storage area within the Western Sydney International Airport site. Excavated material has been identified for sustainable reuse as part of future construction at Western Sydney International Airport.

Heavy vehicle deliveries and haulage will be via Badgerys Creek Road, The Northern Road, Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road and will be carried out during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Deliveries and haulage will be carried out 24 hours a day, seven days a week when tunnelling starts early in 2023. The community will be notified in advance of this activity.

Traffic changes:

During these works, there may be some impacts to roads including increased heavy vehicle movements. For the safety of road users, traffic control will be in place when required to assist with any changes to traffic conditions. All deliveries will be in line with Road Occupancy Licence requirements and Transport for NSW requirements for the movement of oversized vehicles.

Tunnel boring machine component delivery	Ongoing from November
Tunnel boring machine assembly	Ongoing from December

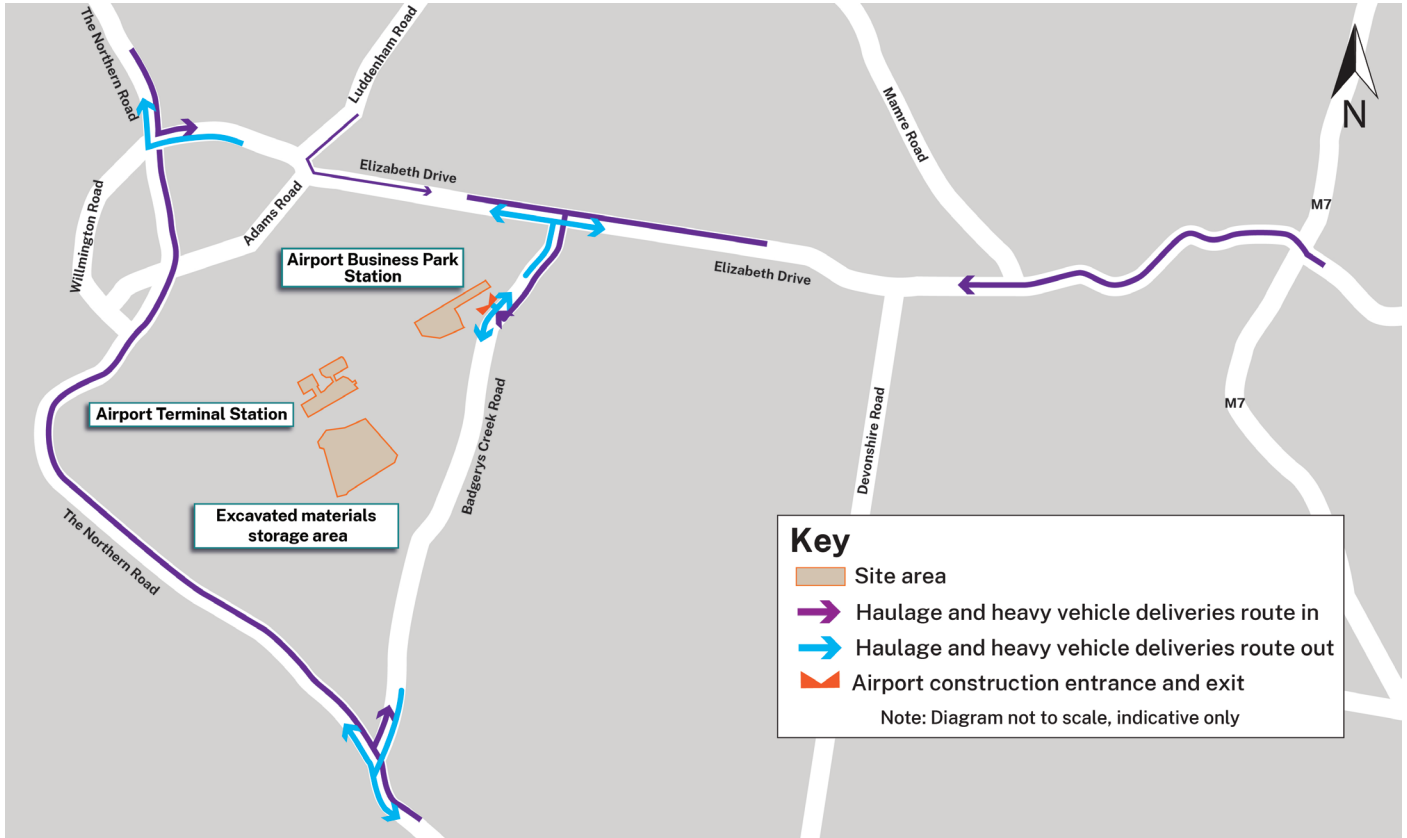
