

Notification – Parramatta

12 September 2022

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont, and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver the Western Tunnelling Package which involves nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Out of hours utility investigations - George Street, Parramatta

Work to confirm the location of existing underground utility services will start on George Street next week to assist with planning for the start of construction. This will involve excavating slit trenches and potholes on the southern footpath, near the Church Street intersection. A map showing the location of the utility investigations is over the page.

To minimise interruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, the work will be undertaken at night. This will start on **Monday 19 September 2022** and continue for approximately five weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

In September, night work is scheduled to take place between **6pm and 7am** on:

- **Monday 19, Tuesday 20 and Thursday 22 September 2022**
- **Monday 26, Tuesday 27 and Thursday 29 September 2022.**

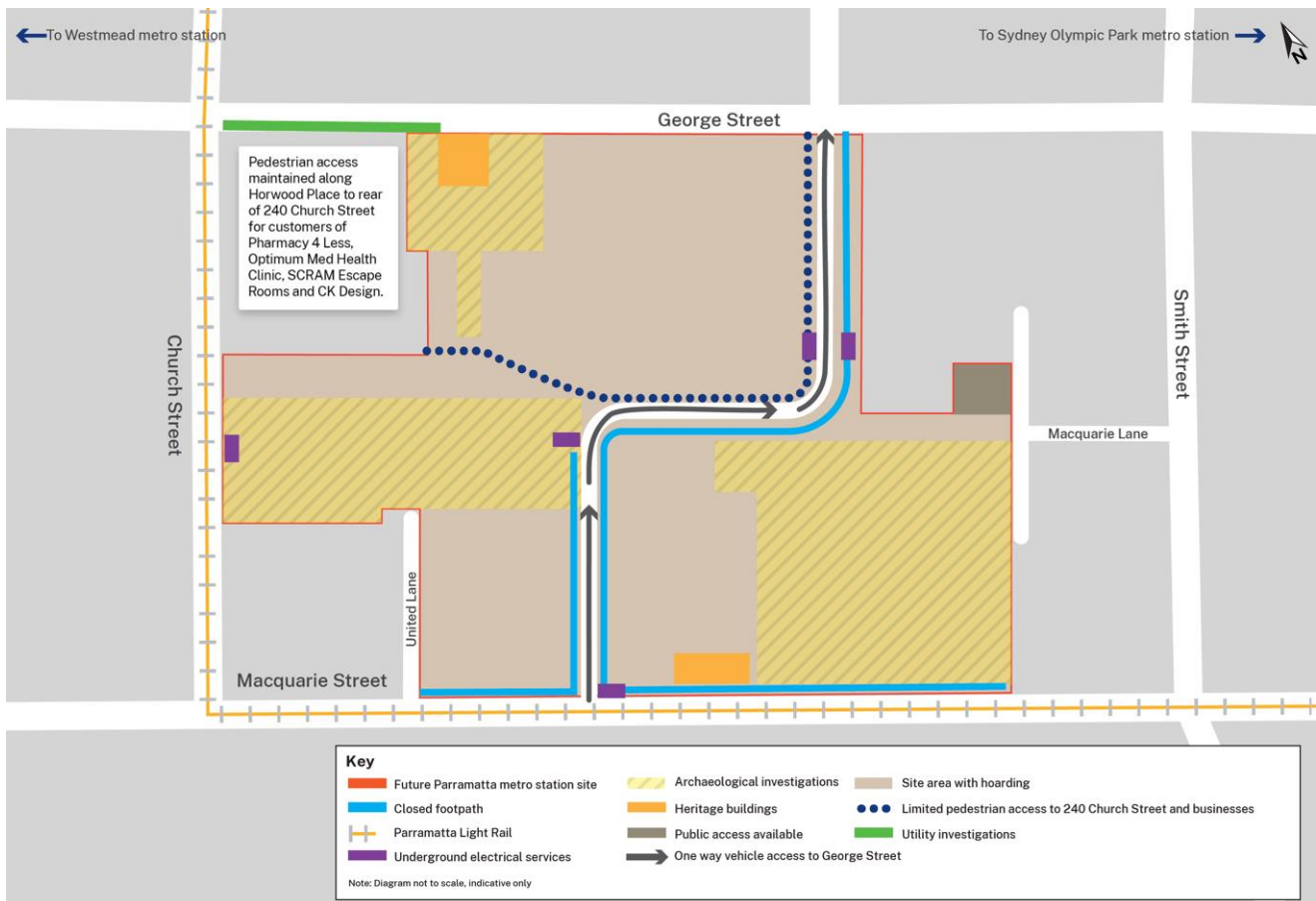
Information about out-of-hours work in October will be included in our October notification.

What to expect:

- The work will generate some noise, but this will be minimised as much as possible
- Once the utility investigations are complete, the impacted areas of the footpath will be reinstated.
- Access to businesses will be maintained, unless arrangements are made with you in advance
- Some parking spaces will be temporarily removed on the southern side of George Street
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas
- Environmental measures are in place to mitigate construction impacts, including noise and vibration monitoring and dust suppression
- We do not need to interrupt your power supply to do this work.

Equipment used: Equipment for this work will include but is not limited to hand tools, road saw, vacuum excavation trucks, tipper trucks and traffic control devices.
