

Notification – St Marys

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

Construction activities

The Temporary Bus Interchange at St Marys has been operational since 7 March 2022. To assist with pedestrian wayfinding, line marking and signage installation will be carried out around the Temporary Bus Interchange, Queen Street, and Nariel Street.

Work is expected to start from **Monday 7 November 2022** and will **continue for one week**, weather and site conditions permitting. Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Residents and businesses will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work. Please see map overleaf to inform work locations.

Work will include:

- Line marking across the Kiss and Ride bays on Nariel Street. The Kiss and Ride bays on Nariel Street will be closed off individually while the work is carried out
- Core drilling to install new sign posts within the Temporary Bus Interchange, on Queen Street and Nariel Street
- Installation of signage within the Temporary Bus Interchange, on Queen Street and Nariel Street
- Installation of signage on the bus shelters within the Temporary Bus Interchange. The bus stops will continue to operate. At times where a bus shelter is closed off, buses will continue to stop at the relevant bus sign
- Reinstating the work areas following completion of work.

What to expect:

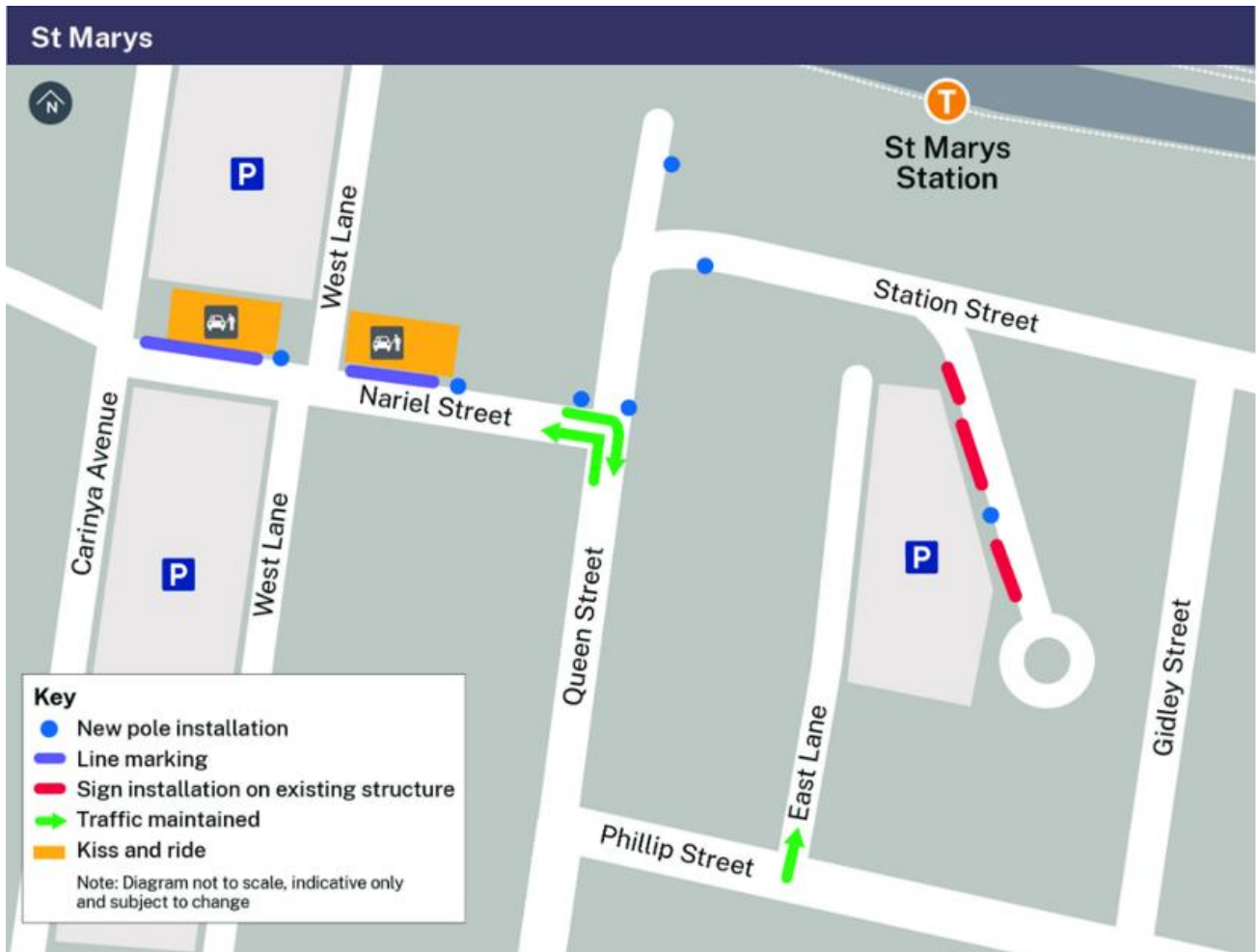
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic safely around work areas
- Increased vehicle movements in and around the site
- Some activities will generate noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise these impacts
- Access for motorists and pedestrians will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to cordless drills, shovels, core drill, generator, step ladders, line marking equipment, barriers and traffic management devices.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions.
