

Monthly construction update – Badgerys Creek and Luddenham

December 2022 and January 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors and United Infrastructure Joint Venture (CPBUI JV) was awarded the Surface and Civil Alignment Works contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport in March 2022.

Work in December and January 2023 will include:

- Completion of site, geotechnical and contamination investigations north of Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek and north and south of Luddenham Road, Luddenham
- Completion of the access road and site compound off Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek
- Commencing piling for the bridge over the new M12 Motorway
- Fortnightly aerial land surveys of the surface alignment to inform the construction design and planning of the project
- Road surveys along Badgerys Creek Road, Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road with traffic control in place to maintain road safety regulations
- Continuing fencing works between Cosgroves Creek and Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek, and between Luddenham Road and Cosgroves Creek, Luddenham
- Delivery of oversized plant and equipment to the site compound off Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek.

What to expect:

- Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.**
- An increase in heavy vehicles entering the site compound off Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek
- Increased vehicle movements on surrounding roads.

Equipment used:

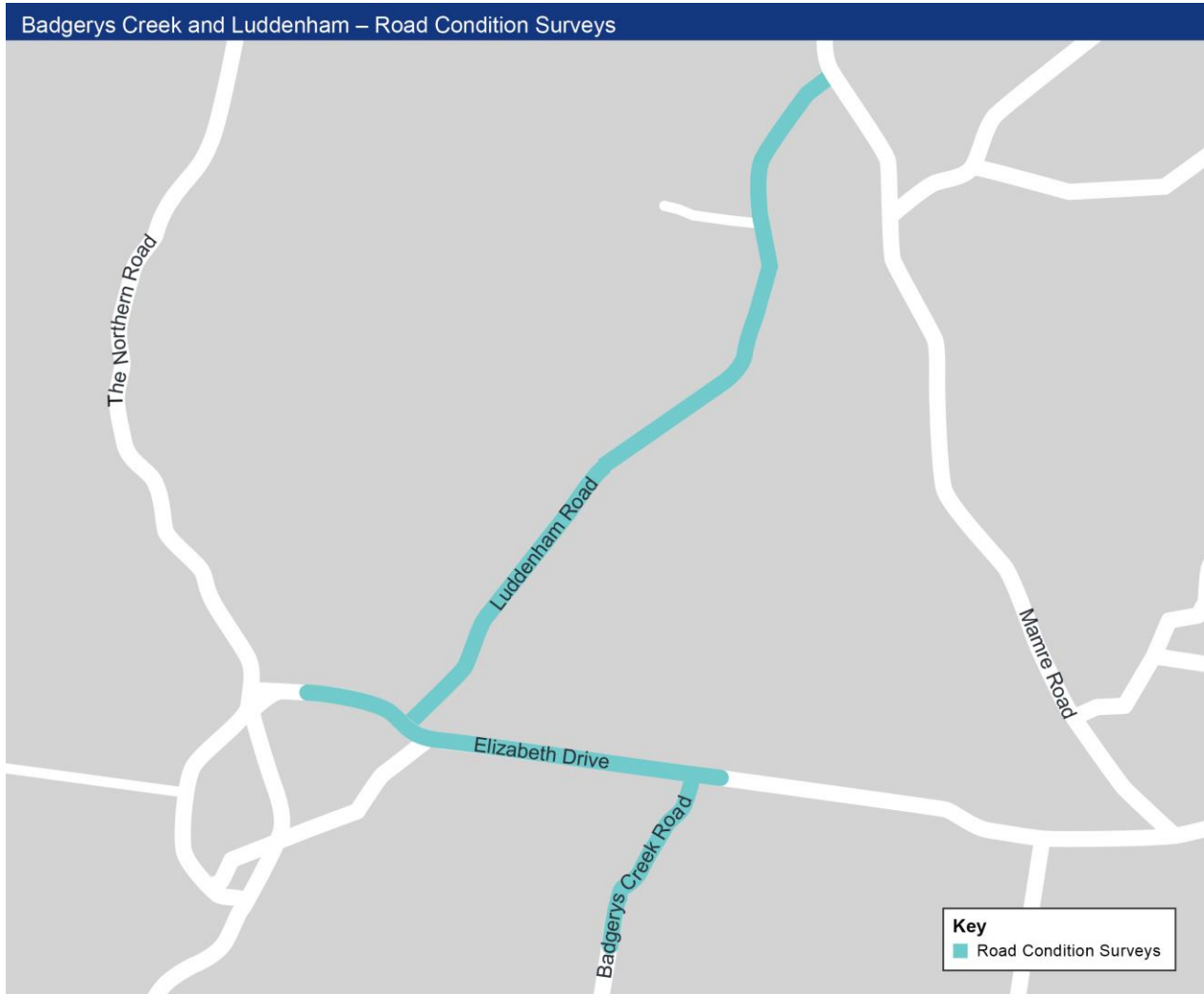
Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to survey equipment including marker pegs and pickets, flagging, survey trailer, hand tools, mobile drill rig, excavator, backhoe, trucks, vacuum truck, portable toilets, temporary shipping container, light and heavy vehicles, surveying drone and drone remote control.

Out-of-hours work:

The project team may be required to carry out oversized deliveries to the site compound off Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek outside of standard construction hours throughout December and January due to road safety regulations. The work is not expected to be noisy. We will contact any directly impacted residents regarding this work. 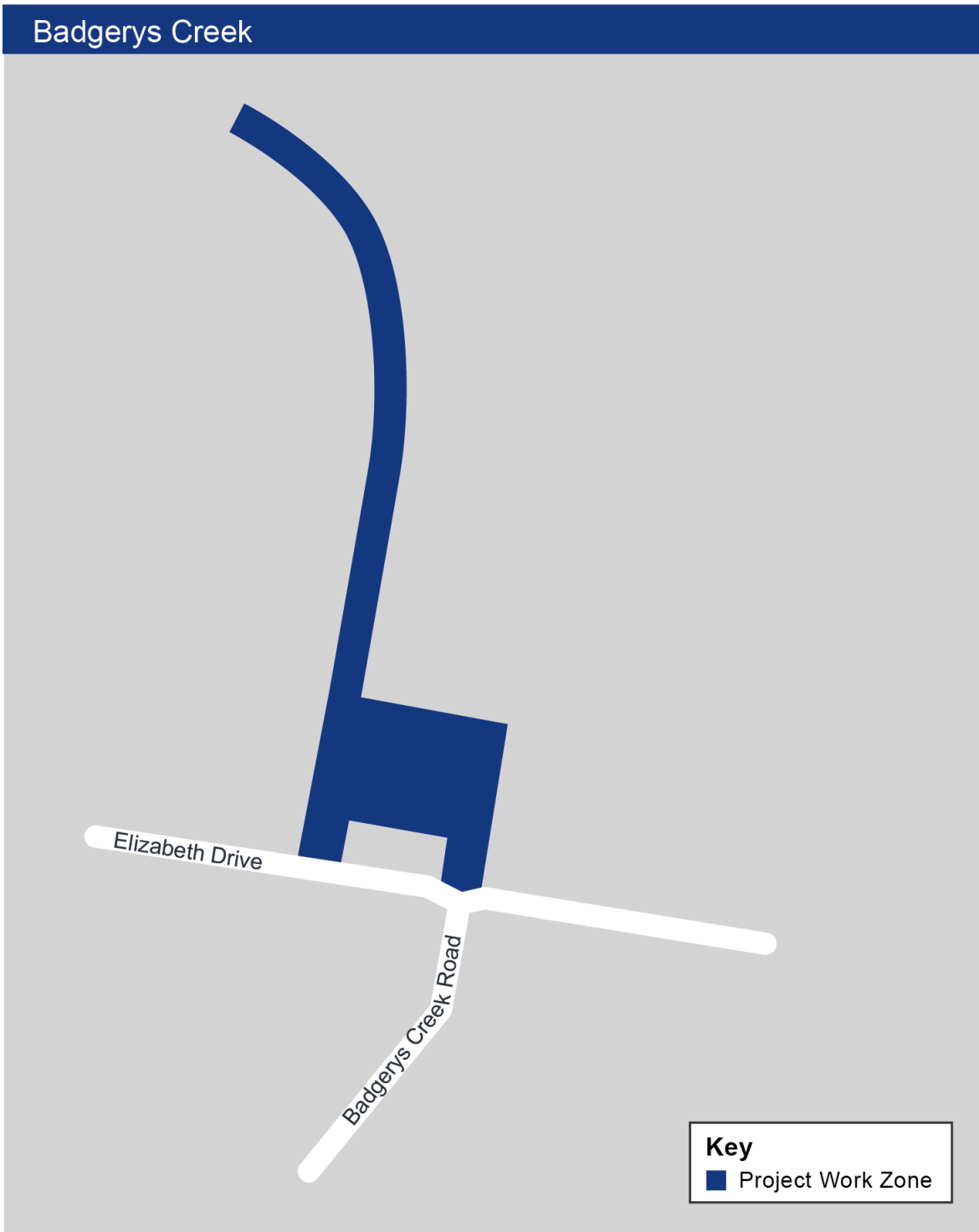

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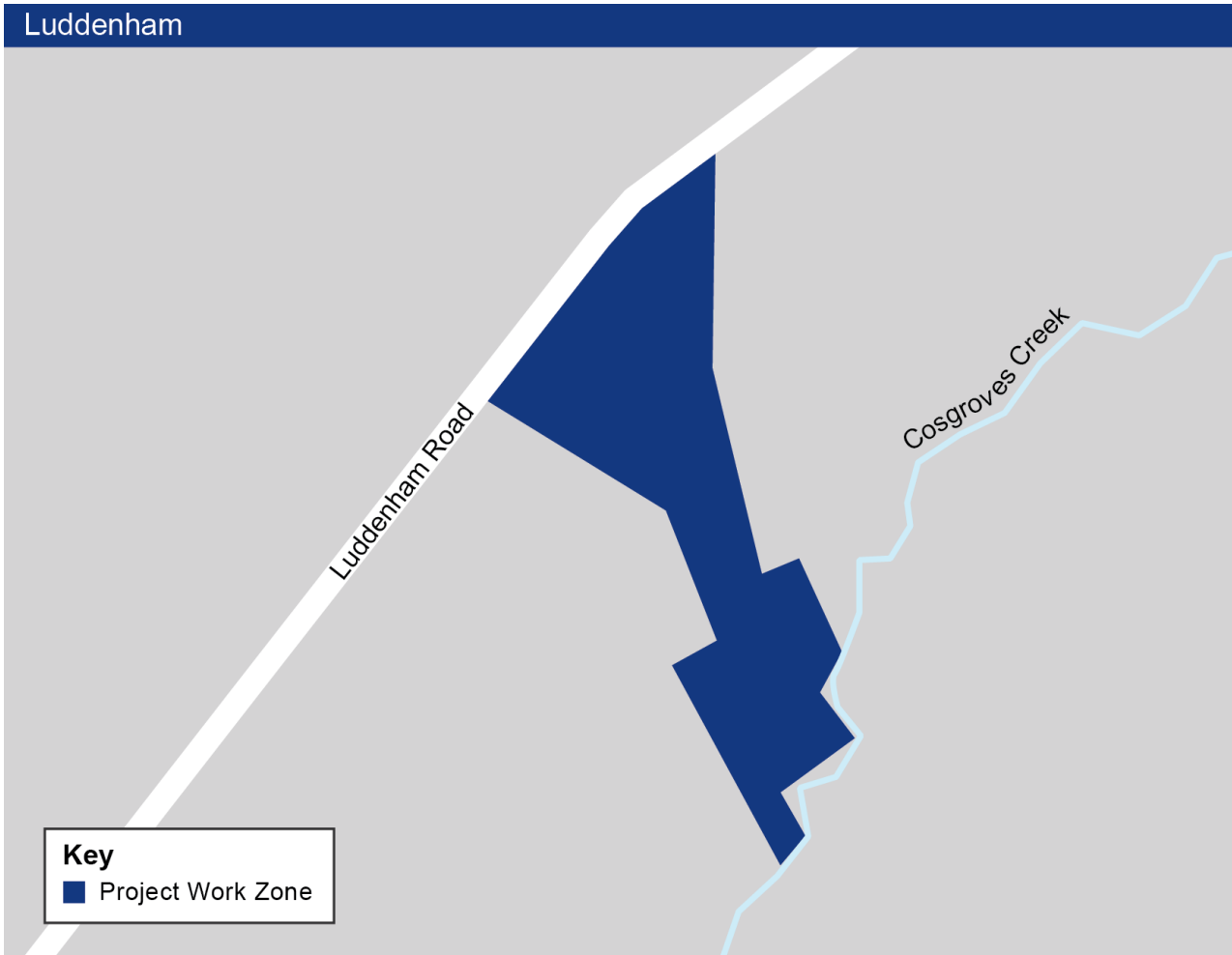
Badgerys Creek section of surface alignment
