

# Notification – Sydney Olympic Park

November 2022

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Sydney Olympic Park.

## Construction update – Low impact out-of-hours work

AFJV will carry out low impact work within the Sydney Olympic Park metro station site outside standard construction hours. This work may include loading out of excavated material between **5:30am and 7am, Monday to Friday** and applying shotcrete onto the excavated walls inside the station box between **6pm and 10:30pm, Monday to Friday**.

### What to expect

- Very low noise levels are expected from this low impact work
- Construction vehicles including trucks and staff will access and exit the site via established driveways with traffic controllers
- Lighting towers will be used and directed away from adjoining properties
- There will be no changes to traffic, pedestrian or cyclist routes.

### Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes excavators, trucks, elevated working platform, shotcrete pump, small tools and light vehicles.
