

# Notification – Construction update

28 December 2022

## Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

### Road restoration work – Darling Street & Merton Street

Work to restore the road on Darling Street is planned to take place between Waterloo Street and Merton Street. Work north of Victoria Road will begin from Wednesday 4 January during standard construction hours. Out-of-hours work will continue from Tuesday 10 January until Friday 14 January between 7pm and 5am.

Parking will be temporarily removed prior to the commencement of work and re-instated upon completion of the work. Alternate parking is available **on surrounding streets in the area**. In the event of unforeseen circumstances or poor weather conditions, work will take place on the next available night/s.

#### Work will involve

- Establishing temporary traffic controls, road line marking and construction areas
- Concrete and asphalt breaking, excavation and removal
- Saw cutting
- Concrete pouring and asphalt placing
- Backfilling and temporarily reinstating the excavated area

#### What to expect

- Construction machinery and equipment operating onsite
- Increased heavy and light vehicle movements in the area
- This work will generate noise and vibration, the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Temporary removal of parking during the construction period

- Temporary road and lane closures during the construction period
- Driveway access may be temporarily interrupted during construction. Impacted properties will be notified prior to discuss details
- Pedestrian access to buildings and footpath will be maintained at all times.

## Equipment used

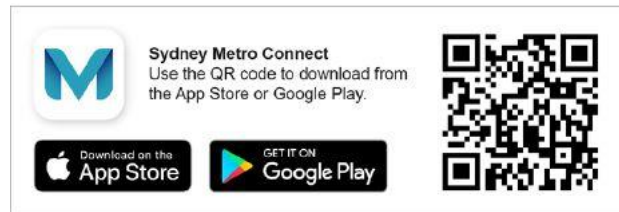
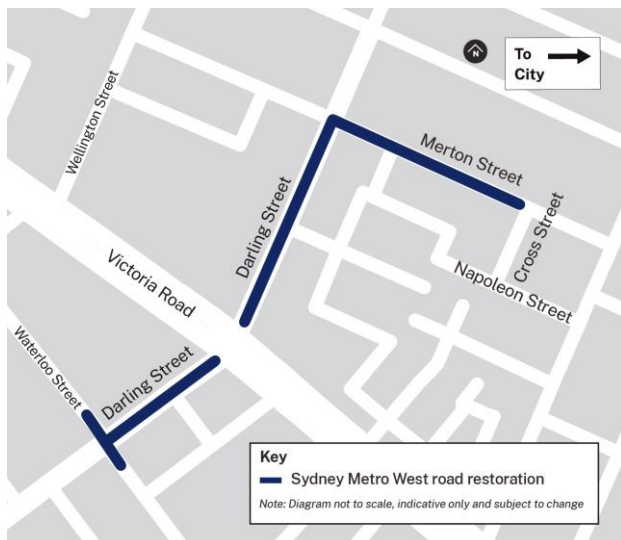
Equipment used will include but not be limited to excavators, road saw (when required), concrete agitator, tippers, sucker trucks & vacuum trucks (if required), traffic control vehicles, lighting towers, hand powered tools and equipment, milling machines, rollers and hammer drills.

## Changes to traffic pedestrian and cycle routes – Traffic changes

During the work, changes to traffic conditions for pedestrians, cyclists, parking, and motorists will be required and include stop-slow traffic controls. Please allow for extra time when travelling while construction work is taking place. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists.
