

Notification – St Marys

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

Construction activities

Site establishment work will commence for the new project site office on Harris Street, St Marys. The site office will be used by the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project team for the duration of the project.

Work is expected to start from **Tuesday 3 January 2023 and will continue for up to 4 weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Residents and businesses will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work. From **Monday 9 January 2023** approximately six on-street parking spaces will be permanently removed from the southern side of Harris Street to facilitate construction staging for the site office. Please see map overleaf to inform work location.

Work will include:

- Installation of site fencing and shadecloth
- Survey, utilities and geotechnical investigations
- Installation of site amenities and power supply work
- Stormwater and sewer connection work
- Modification to the existing driveway layback at the car park.

What to expect:

- Up to six on-street parking spaces will be permanently removed from Harris Street
- Increased vehicle movements around the site
- Some activities will generate noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise these impacts
- Access for motorists and pedestrians along Harris Street will be maintained.

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to drill rig, excavators, delivery trucks, mobile crane, testing trucks, survey equipment, generators and light vehicles.

Other parking nearby:

Transport for NSW has recently delivered an additional 250 parking spaces to the multi-storey commuter car park adjacent to the work site. We recommend commuters use this parking at St Marys Station.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions.
