

# **Notification - St Marys**

# Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

## **Ongoing construction activities: Harris Street**

Site establishment work at St Marys is continuing over the next four weeks for construction of the site project office on Harris Street. Please see map overleaf for work location.

Most of this work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. There will be some out-of-hours work occurring on Station Street which is outlined below.

#### Work during standard hours will include:

- Installation of site fencing and shadecloth
- Installation of site amenities and power supply work
- Stormwater and sewer connection work.

### **Out-of-hours work on Station Street, St Marys**

Asphalting repair work will take place at the bus interchange on Station Street, St Marys. This work is required to upgrade a small section of road pavement on Station Street.

Due to the impact of asphalting activities on buses and pedestrians, this work will be completed at night when bus and pedestrian movements are lower. Activities will include removing and replacing a section of road on Station Street and laying new asphalt. This work will take no more than two night shifts between Tuesday 31 January and Friday 17 February 2023 from 8pm to 5am.

### Out-of-hours work will include:

- Removing a section of the existing road pavement on Station Street
- Laying new asphalt to a section of the road on Station Street
- Reinstating the work areas following completion of work.

#### What to expect:

- Increased vehicle movements around the bus interchange during night work
- Some activities will generate noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise these impacts including completing loud noise activities at the start of each night shift

#### **Equipment used:**

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to excavator, profiler, asphalt paver, spray seal truck, roller, drill rig, delivery trucks, concrete trucks, mobile crane, testing trucks, survey equipment, generators, light vehicles and various hand tools.



#### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the out-of-hours work there may be some increased construction vehicle movements. For the safety of road users, traffic control will be in place when required to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions.
