

Monthly update – Burwood North

30 January 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including Burwood North Station.

Work during February

Site establishment work will continue within and around the Burwood North Station sites throughout February. Excavation of the station box and tunnelling for the underground pedestrian walkway and crossover cavern is continuing on the northern site and piling on the southern site.

Work during February includes:

- Construction of the acoustic shed, bridge and gantry crane on the northern site
- Construction of retaining structures such as ground anchors on the northern site
- Excavation of the station box and loading out excavated material from the northern site
- Tunnel excavation for the underground pedestrian walkway and crossover cavern
- Rock bolting and shotcrete spraying within the station box excavation
- Concreting work on both sites including slabs, pavements and retaining walls
- Civil works for temporary structures on site, such as internal driveway and spoil sheds
- Ground levelling, including vibratory rolling for compaction on the southern construction site
- Construction of the piling platform and piling for the permanent retaining wall for the southern construction site
- Utility and civil work on Burwood and Parramatta roads as well as Burton, Loftus and Gipps streets
- Installation and removal of fencing, scaffolding and hoarding which will be adjusted as work progresses
- Tunnel lining machine assembly
- Utility work for new driveways and construction of new driveways on both sites
- Installation of underground services for onsite utility connections
- Delivery and pick up of oversize equipment to and from both sites

This work will be carried out during standard construction hours:

Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 6pm

Work outside standard construction hours

Some of the utility relocation, hoarding adjustment and driveway construction work as well as oversize deliveries must be undertaken outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

This out-of-hours work will be carried out progressively on Burwood Road, Parramatta Road, Burton Street and Loftus Street (corner of Paramatta Road) between 8pm and 5am on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from **Monday 6 February to Friday 3 March 2023**. At times, low impact concreting work may extend beyond standard construction hours between 6pm and 10pm during weekdays.

Equipment used

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: trucks, light vehicles, excavators, graders, watercarts, concrete saws, bobcats, jack hammers, dozer, roadheader, vacuum trucks, vibratory rollers, drill rigs, concrete pumps and hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including partial road and footpath closures on Burwood Road, Burton, Loftus and Gipps streets and Parramatta Road. During some deliveries to the northern site, up to four (4) parking spaces near the construction site driveway on Burton Street will need to be temporarily removed. Property and driveway access will be maintained at all times.
