

Notification – Orchard Hills

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors Ghella was awarded the tunnelling contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport in December 2021.

Out-of-hours work: Kent and Lansdowne Roads

Work to upgrade the existing asphalt on Kent and Lansdowne Roads and associated activities will be carried out over three nights between **6pm and 6am from Monday 30 January to Wednesday 1 February 2023**, weather and site conditions permitting. This work is required to be completed outside standard work hours in line with Transport for NSW Road Occupancy Licence conditions, and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers around the site.

Work will include:

- Installing barriers and traffic control devices to secure the work area
- Removing sections of asphalt at Kent and Lansdowne Roads
- Installing and compacting new asphalt
- Line marking once asphaltting is complete.

What to expect:

- Work activities will generate noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise these impacts including noise and vibration monitoring, and dust suppression.
- Light spill from temporary construction lighting. Lights will be directed away from houses where possible
- Increased worker and vehicle movements on Kent and Lansdowne Roads.

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to light towers, asphalt trucks, paving machine and drum rollers.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow and stop-slow traffic controls. Driveway access will be maintained, with potential short delays if asphaltting works are crossing driveways.


