

Notification – Parramatta

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Pedestrian fencing installation – Pitt Street, Parramatta

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will commence installation of additional fencing to improve pedestrian safety along Pitt Street, Parramatta. Fencing will be installed adjacent to Parramatta High School from **Monday 30 January to Thursday 16 February 2023**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Out-of-hours work

Work activities must be undertaken outside standard construction hours in accordance with road occupancy approvals to minimise disruption to local traffic and ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians.

Out-of-hours activities will be conducted for three weeks between **7pm and 6am on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday nights from Monday 30 January to Thursday 16 February 2023**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will involve:

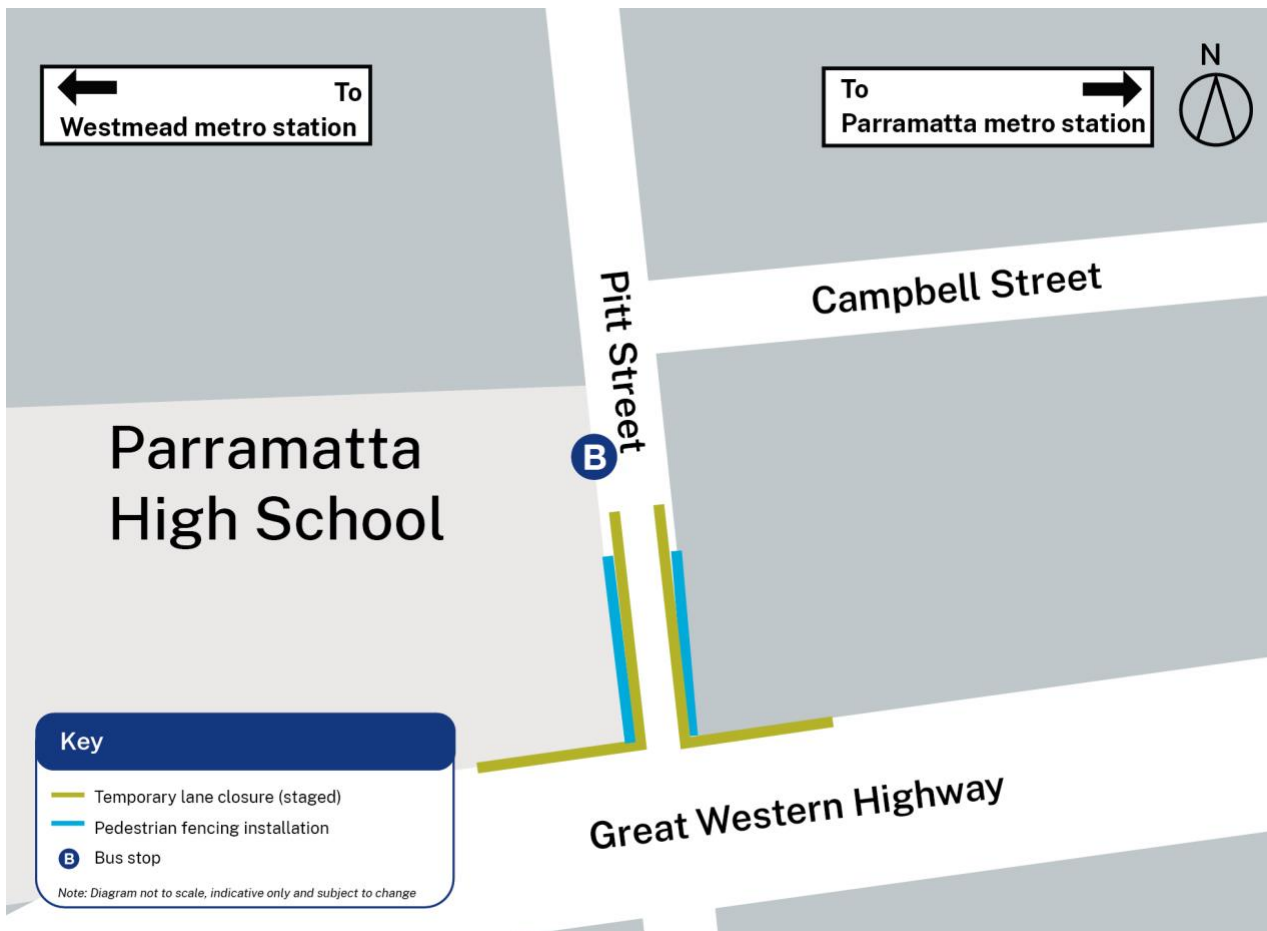
- Setting up traffic management and a lane closure on the corner of Pitt Street and the Great Western Highway to manage traffic flow
- Excavating, installing and concreting new fencing and fence posts into the existing footpath.

What to expect:

- Access to driveways and bus stops will be maintained
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties
- Noise, vibration and dust monitoring will be conducted
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas

Equipment used: Equipment for this work will include but is not limited to hand tools, trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers, concrete agitators, vacuum trucks, delivery vehicles, temporary fencing, road saw and traffic control devices.
