

Notification - St Marys

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

Construction activities

Work at St Marys is continuing over the next four weeks for construction of the site project office on Harris Street. Most of this work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Weekend out-of-hours work will be carried out on **Saturdays 7am to 5pm and Sundays 7am to 2pm**.

Site investigation will be undertaken in the area between the rail corridor and the St Marys Multi-Storey Commuter Car Park on Harris Street during standard work hours. Work will include drilling boreholes to test ground materials. Survey work will also take place on the station platforms during off-peak hours with minimal disruption to customers. Work will include:

- Ongoing site establishment activities including fencing, signage, site sheds and facilities
- Installation and commissioning of a tower crane
- Civil works for ground footings
- Screw piling
- Installation of structural steel and timber
- Material lifts using the tower crane
- Construction of swept paths, including a new trafficable layback
- Delivery of plant and equipment.

What to expect:

- The tower crane will be delivered and installed onto site on Saturday 4 March. Commissioning of the tower crane will occur on Sunday 5 March, weather permitting
- Increased vehicle movements around the site
- Some activities will generate noise, vibration and dust. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise these impacts.

Equipment used:


Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to excavator, mobile crane, tower crane, delivery trucks, concrete trucks, survey equipment, power tools, bore rigs, light vehicles and various hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work there may be some increased construction vehicle movements. For the safety of road users, traffic control will be in place when required to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.
