

## Notification – Sydney Olympic Park

13 February 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Sydney Olympic Park.

### Out-of-hours work

AFJV will be carrying out utility work on Herb Elliott Avenue, near the entrance to the Sydney Olympic Park metro station site. This work must occur outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Night work will occur in the work area shown on the map overleaf between **6pm and 6am on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday nights from Monday 20 February to Thursday 9 March 2023.**

### Night work will include:

- Saw cutting the existing surface
- Investigating to expose services and test for redundancy
- Installing new electrical conduits
- Reinstating the pavement / road surface where required

### What to expect

- Noise blankets will be used to minimise disturbance
- Saw cutting and hammering work will be completed by midnight
- There will be no disruption to supply of utility services
- There will be some noise associated with this work and we will try to minimise this as much as possible
- Property and business access will be maintained at all times
- At times, there will be temporary footpath and parking lane closures during this work

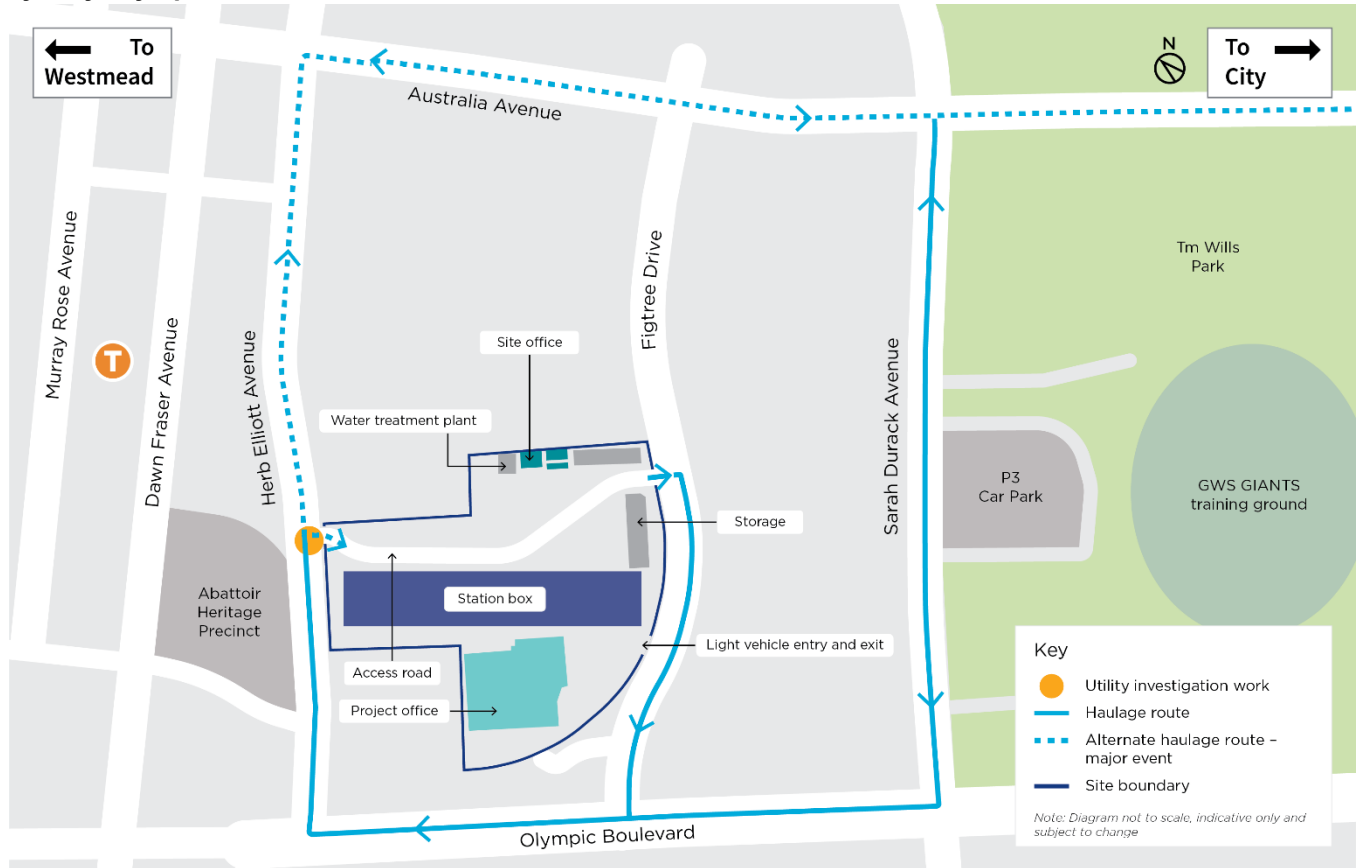
### Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: road saw, generator, lighting tower, vacuum truck, street sweeper, trucks and light vehicles.

### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

The utility works will require some footpath and partial lane closures. Traffic control will be in place and two-way traffic will be maintained.
