

Notification – Revised Construction update

14 February 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Line marking – Darling Street & Merton Street

Due to unforeseen circumstances and poor weather conditions, line marking work previously notified to take place on Wednesday 8 February has been postponed.

Line marking to complete recent road restoration work on Darling Street (between Waterloo Street and Merton Street) and on Merton Street (between Darling Street and Cross Street) will now take place on Wednesday 15 February, weather permitting. Due to road authority requirements, this work must be undertaken out-of-hours between 7pm and 5am.

Parking will be temporarily removed on Darling Street between National Street and Merton Street, and between Belmore Street and Victoria Road prior to the commencement of work. All parking will be re-instated upon completion of the work.

Alternate parking is available **on surrounding streets in the area**. In the event of unforeseen circumstances or poor weather conditions, work will take place on the next available night/s.

Work will involve

- Establishing temporary traffic controls
- Road line marking

What to expect

- Machinery and equipment operating onsite
- Increased light vehicle movements in the area
- This work will generate noise and vibration, the team will minimise impacts where possible
- Temporary removal of parking during the construction period
- Temporary lane closures during the construction period
- Pedestrian access to buildings and footpath will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used

Equipment used will include but not be limited to light vehicles and personnel carrying line marking equipment.

Changes to traffic pedestrian and cycle routes – Traffic changes

During the work, changes to traffic conditions for pedestrians, cyclists, parking, and motorists will be required and include stop-slow traffic controls. Please allow for extra time when travelling while construction work is taking place. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists.

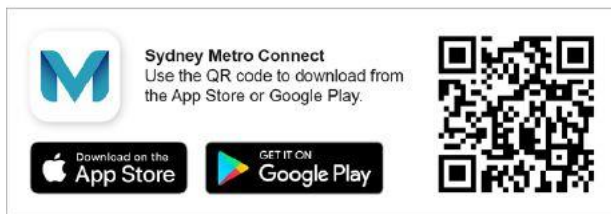
