

## Monthly construction update – Badgerys Creek and Luddenham

April 2023

### Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors and United Infrastructure Joint Venture (CPBUI JV) was awarded the Surface and Civil Alignment Works contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport in March 2022.

#### Work in April will include:

- Construction of a kerb and slip lane on Luddenham Road (North and South maps)
- Deliveries of sandstone and spoil to the Elizabeth Drive site compound
- Construction of the M12 bridge
- Earthworks and piling in Luddenham North and South to prepare for the viaduct installations
- Earthworks on Airport Land for the connection to the Sydney Metro tunnel entry
- Fortnightly aerial land surveys of the surface alignment to inform the construction design and planning of the project
- Fencing of the project alignment between the Warragamba Pipelines, Luddenham and Airport Land, Badgerys Creek.

#### What to expect:

- Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 1pm.**
- An increase in heavy vehicles entering the site compound off Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek and Luddenham Road, Luddenham
- Increased vehicle movements on surrounding roads
- Please see maps overleaf showing work locations.

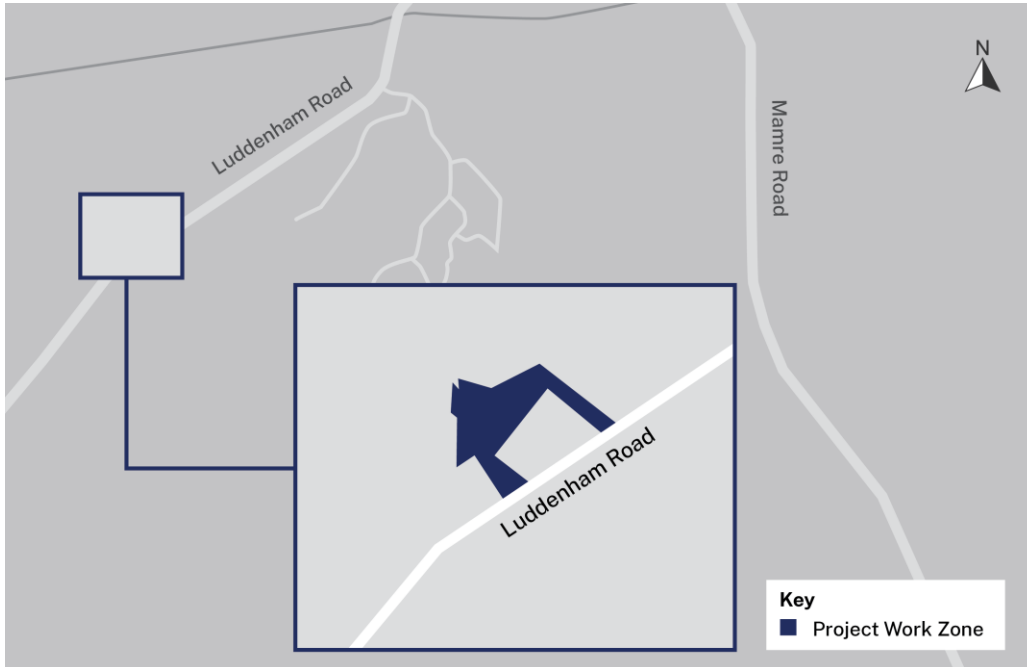
#### Out-of-hours work:

The project team may need to carry out spoil deliveries to the Elizabeth Drive Site Compound outside of standard construction hours from February 2023 through to December 2023. Additionally, the project team may need to carry out the Luddenham Road, Luddenham kerb and slip road work outside of standard construction hours. These works are not expected to be noisy. We will contact directly impacted residents regarding these works. Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to survey equipment including marker pegs and pickets, flagging, hand tools, mobile drill rig, excavator, backhoe, trucks, vacuum truck, portable toilets, temporary shipping container, water carts, light and heavy vehicles, surveying drone and drone remote control.
