

Notification – Westmead

2 March 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont, and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Transport for Tomorrow (T4T) has been awarded the contract to undertake enabling work at the existing Westmead Station to prepare the site for construction of Sydney Metro. This work primarily involves the relocation of existing services within the rail corridor.

T4T work at Westmead – March and April

Work will be ongoing within our construction sites and in local streets during standard construction hours 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm on Saturday.

Out-of-hours works will occur during scheduled Sydney Trains track work weekends, when trains are not running to minimise disruption to commuter services and / or road traffic. Scheduled dates for March and April include:

- **6pm Friday 31 March until 7am Monday 3 April 2023**

We are required to complete some cable containment and low voltage equipment installation work outside of standard construction hours (7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm on Saturday) **from March until Saturday 15 April**. These activities will take place inside the station concourse and on platforms 3 & 4.

Transport for Tomorrow work:

- Removal of redundant cables
- Removal of poles and conductors requiring temporary road closures on Alexandra Avenue and Park Parade
- Installation of cable containment and low voltage equipment work
- Minor finishing and rectification work.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist routes:

From 8pm Saturday 1 April until 8am Sunday 2 April, changes to vehicle access will be in place on Alexandra Avenue and Park Parade between Bridge Road and Pitt Street. Hawkesbury Road will remain accessible. Local access will be maintained and detours will be in place.

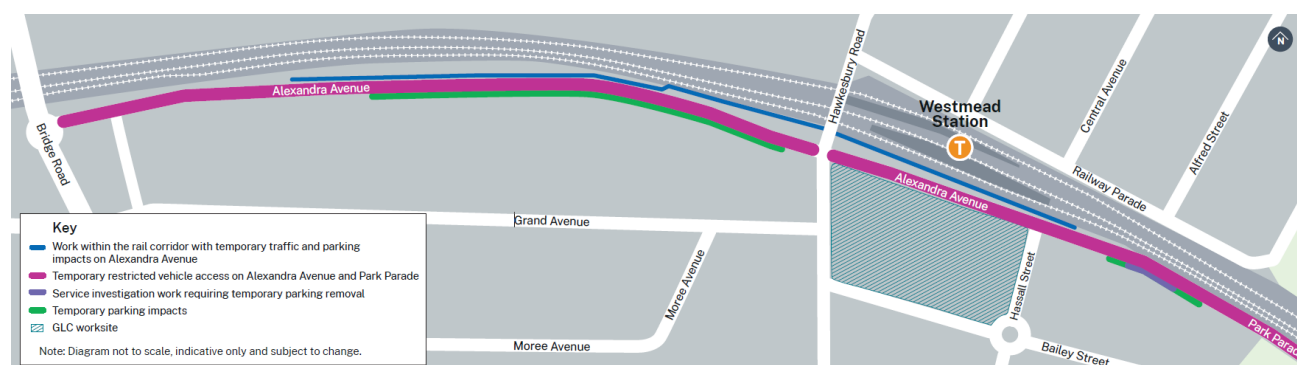
To facilitate access to our work areas and safely operate machinery, **parking access will be temporarily removed in some sections of Alexandra Avenue in April**. Please see map for work

locations and areas where parking removal will be required. Access to pathways, properties and Westmead Station will be maintained at all times.

Residents and businesses affected by temporary power interruptions will be notified directly prior to work commencing.

Equipment used for work includes but is not limited to excavators, cranes, semi-trailers, elevated work platforms, generators, vacuum truck, hand tools, chainsaws, tipper and light vehicles.
