

## Notification – Westmead

13 April 2023

### Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

### Traffic lane modifications – Hassall Street and Alexandra Avenue, Westmead

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will commence traffic lane modifications from **Thursday 20 April to Friday 28 April**. This work includes new line marking on Hassall Street and Alexandra Avenue to create a right turn lane into the Westmead metro station site and lane adjustments to improve traffic flow. These work activities and changes include the following:

- Permanent parking removal on the eastern side of Hassall Street, between Alexandra Avenue and Bailey Street
- Establishing a right turn lane into the Westmead metro station site from Hassall Street
- Maintaining a single traffic lane southbound on Hassall Street, between Alexandra Avenue and Bailey Street
- Reducing the northbound traffic lanes from Hassall Street to Alexandra Avenue from two lanes to one
- Changes to line marking on Alexandra Avenue and Hassall Street

### Out-of-hours work

Work activities must be undertaken outside standard construction hours in accordance with road occupancy approvals to minimise disruption to local traffic and ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians.

Out-of-hours activities will occur between **6pm and 7am on the nights listed below**, weather and site conditions permitting.

- **Thursday 20 April and Friday 21 April**
- **Thursday 27 April and Friday 28 April**

Work on these nights will involve:

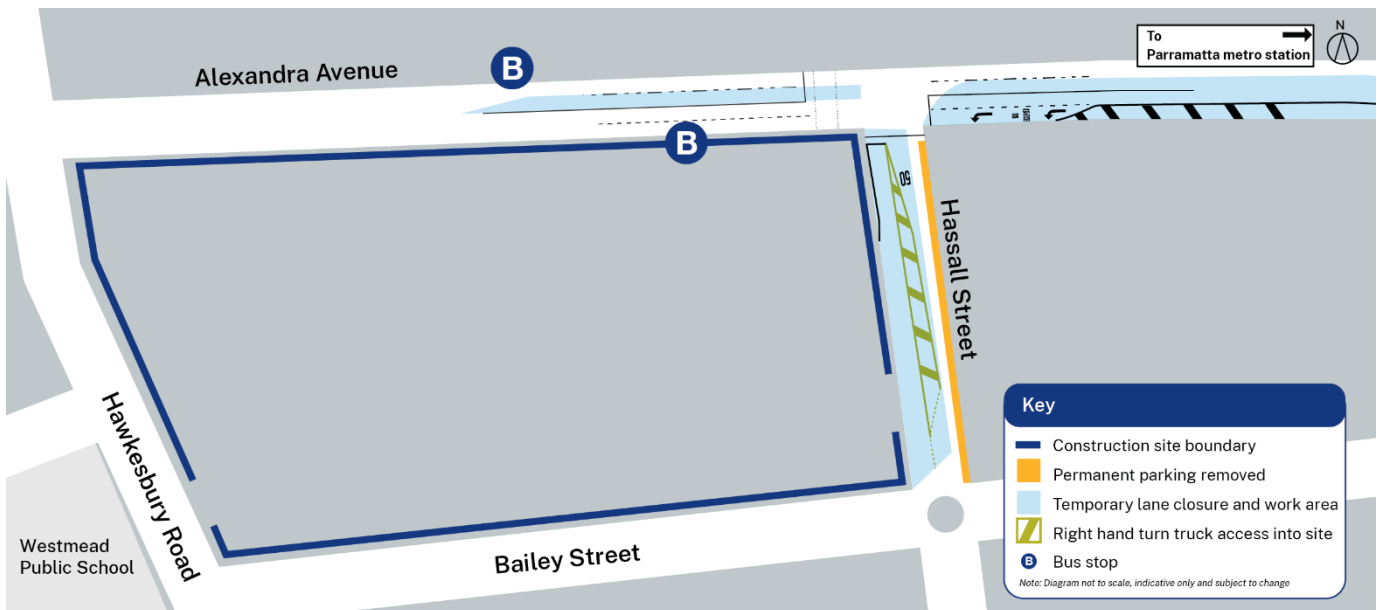
- Setting up traffic control
- Temporary lane closures in place on Hassall Street and Alexandra Avenue
- Removing existing line marking on Hassall Street and Alexandra Avenue
- Minor road modifications, resurfacing and asphaltting prior to line marking
- New line marking on Hassall Street and Alexandra Avenue

## What to expect:

- Access to driveways and bus stops will be maintained
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties
- Noise, vibration and dust monitoring will be conducted
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas

**Equipment used:** Equipment for this work will include but is not limited to a high pressure water hose, machinery to remove and cut the asphalt, asphalt truck, tipper trucks, line marking equipment, road saw, light vehicles, lighting towers, roller, excavator, hand tools and traffic control devices.
