



Notification – Central Station

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown, with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have a network of four metro lines, 46 stations, and 113km of new metro rail.

Reinstatement of Chalmers Street bike path and footpath

Work will be undertaken between **8pm Thursday 18 May until 4am Wednesday 24 May 2023** for the reinstatement of the permanent bike path and footpath on Chalmers Street.

The work will involve the removal of asphalt on the current shared path, relocating hoarding and the reinstatement of the cycle path and footpath.

Water-filled barriers will also be relocated between 1am and 3am Friday 19 May 2023 when Light Rail services are not running.

Equipment used for the work will include jackhammers, excavators, rollers, construction vehicles, hand tools and power tools.

A detour will be in place for pedestrians and cyclists during this time. Please see the map overleaf and follow the direction of signage during the works.

All access to residential buildings and shops in the area will be maintained.
