



Notification – Orchard Hills and St Clair 26 May 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A cityshaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

Quickway have been engaged to complete the watermain works for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport.

Vegetation removal, Mamre Road

To prepare for the watermain upgrade work, vegetation removal will commence on Luddenham and Mamre Roads from **Friday 2 June 2023**, and continue for **up to 4 weeks**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday** to **Friday 7am** to **6pm** and **Saturday 8am** to **1pm**. Surrounding businesses and residents will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work.

Work will include:

- Vegetation removal on the roadsides along Luddenham Road, Orchard Hills up to Mamre Road
- Reinstating the work area, once work is complete.

What to expect:

- Work will generate some noise during construction hours and our team will minimise impacts, where possible
- Increased vehicle movements on surrounding roads
- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to barriers, traffic management devices, vacuum excavation vehicle, excavators, heavy vehicles and trailers, drilling rig, roller, concrete agitators, water carts, pneumatic drills, bobcats, chainsaws, generators, compaction rammers, survey equipment, light vehicles, specialist survey vehicles, spoil trucks, large earthworks equipment.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During these works, there may be some impacts to local roads including increased heavy vehicle movements. For the safety of road users, traffic control will be in place when required to assist with any changes to traffic conditions.



Minimising environmental impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise and other factors.
