

Notification – Five Dock

15 June 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovia Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

The tunnelling contractor, AFJV needs to temporarily repair a previously excavated utility trench on the Great North Road footpath near Second Avenue Five Dock. This work must occur outside standard construction hours to minimise interruption to traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

This work will occur overnight on **Thursday 22 June 2023 between 7pm and 5am** with a contingency night on Monday 26 June 2023.

The work will include:

- Removing road plates from the footpath
- Backfilling and compacting the trench
- Laying asphalt to seal the footpath surface

What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible
- There will be no saw cutting or jack hammering involved with this work
- Noise blankets will be in place where practical to reduce noise from this work
- The footpath in the work area on Great North Road near Second Avenue will be closed with a pedestrian detour in place during this work managed by traffic controllers (see map overleaf)
- Access to properties will be maintained

Equipment used:

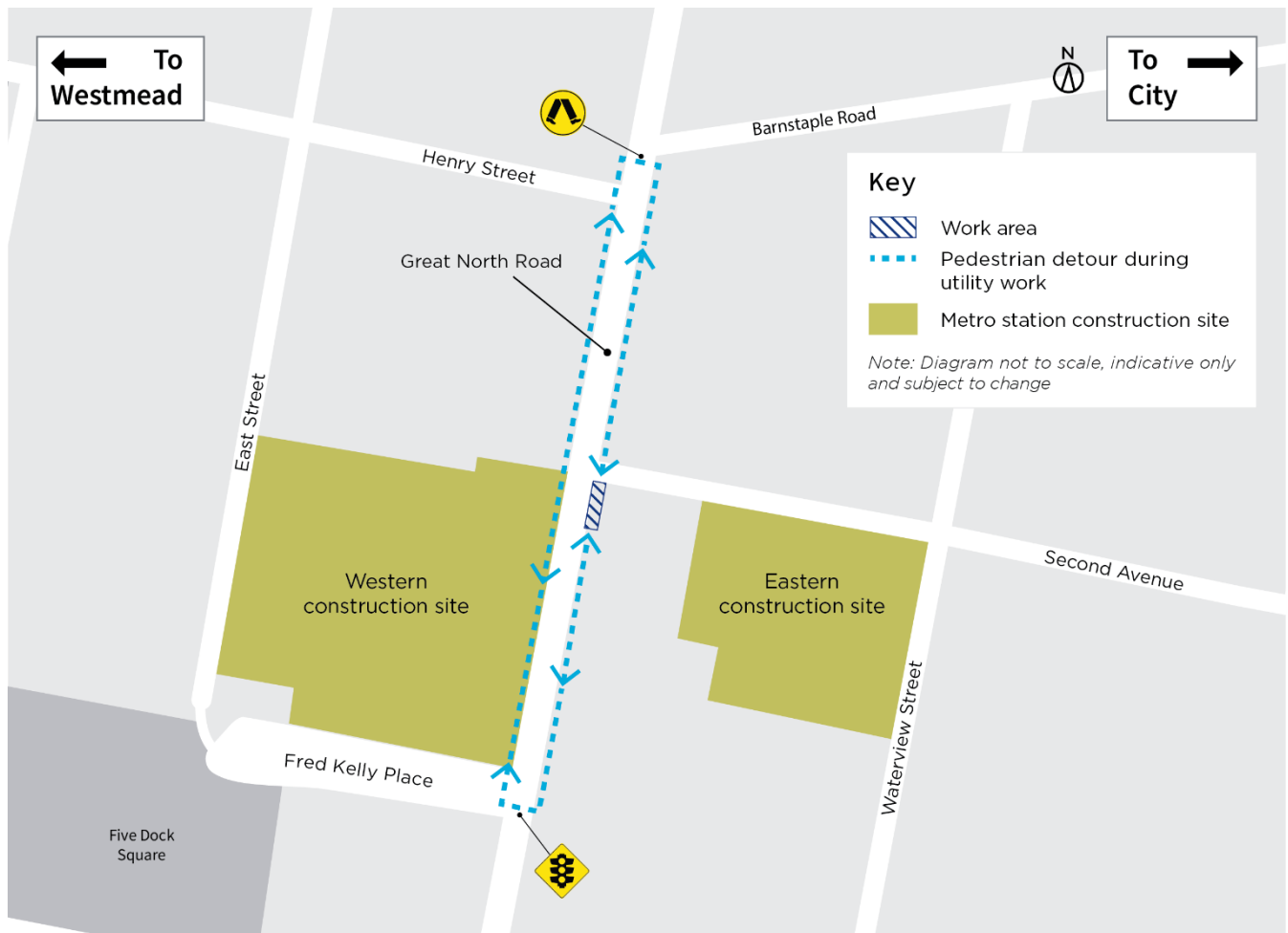
Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: excavator, tipper truck, vacuum truck, plate compactor, light vehicles, lighting towers, power tools, traffic control signage and hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including pedestrian detours during the work.

There will be a temporary footpath closure with a pedestrian detour in place on Great North Road during this out-of-hours work managed by traffic controllers.
