



# **Loading Zone Notification**

July 2023

# Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown, with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have a network of four metro lines, 46 stations, and 113km of new metro rail.

The new Waterloo integrated station development includes construction of the new Waterloo metro station by John Holland, while a joint venture between John Holland and Mirvac will deliver the Waterloo Metro Quarter, including buildings above and next to the station.

### Waterloo over station development construction loading zones

Construction loading zones will be implemented in March will remain until early 2025 to aid with construction activities. The construction loading zones will include:

- Single lane on the northern end of Wellington Street (between Botany Road and Cope Street)
- Single lane on the southern end of Raglan Street (between Botany Road and Cope Street)
- Single lane on the eastern side of Botany Road (between Raglan Street and Wellington Street)

Raglan and Wellington Street loading zones will be in use during standard construction hours Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm. Load zones on Botany Road will only be in use Monday to Friday 10am-3pm.

These loading zone hours are indicative and are subject to change where high risk works on site are scheduled on Saturdays or outside of standard construction hours.


