



Out-of-hours work notification – Barangaroo Station

[Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project](#)

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown, with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

By 2030, Sydney will have a network of four metro lines, 46 stations, and 113km of new metro rail.

BESIX Watpac is building the new Barangaroo Station, including delivering the station fit-out and associated landscaping and civil works, including the re-alignment of Hickson Road.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work which includes installing metro rail track, power systems, communications, and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

[Connection of high-voltage infrastructure from Hickson Road to the Nawi Cove foreshore](#)

Between Sunday 16 July and Sunday 20 August 2023, BESIX Watpac will connect high-voltage infrastructure from Hickson Road to the area in front of the Cutaway at Nawi Cove.

This work will take place during standard construction hours as well as out-of-hours. To ensure the safety of the public and workers, some of the work will at times require a single lane road closure of Hickson Road and/or a closure of the foreshore footpath from Crown Towers to the Cutaway at Nawi Cove.

Out-of-hours work will take place between 6pm and 5am the following day. The table and map on pages 2 & 3 provide full details of the work including dates for road and footpath closures.

Between **Sunday 16 July and Sunday 20 August 2023**, two generators enclosed in acoustic blankets will be in place 24-hours a day, seven days a week, to maintain power to the Cutaway during this work. No other properties will be impacted by the power outages, and we do not expect the generators will cause noise disturbance to residents.

[What to expect](#)

- Traffic management to safely manage the partial closure of Hickson Road and the full closure of the foreshore footpath.
- Temporary lighting to ensure a safe work site which will be directed away from properties.
- Equipment used will be mostly hand tools. At times an excavator with a breaking attachment, tipper truck, tool truck and a vacuum truck will be used.
- The work is expected to be low impact and not noisy for most of the time. However, up to two nights will involve (**noisy**) excavation and this work will cease at midnight on those nights. Noise monitoring will be in place

Our mitigation measures


- All vehicles will be turned off when not in use.
- Communication will be limited to radios only when moving/unloading materials, with no use of horns or loud radios.
- Trucks will avoid reversing onto and in site, where feasible.
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be fitted to plant and machinery.
- Temporary noise blankets will be installed on site, where feasible.

Closure of the foreshore footpath from Crown Towers to the Cutaway

For up to six nights, there will be **no pedestrian access between the northern corner of Crown Towers and just before the entrance to the Cutaway at Nawi Cove between the hours of 8pm and 5am the following day**. Pedestrian access to the Barangaroo headland foreshore and the Cutaway will remain available via High Steps and Barangaroo Reserve. Please refer to the map below, which includes accessible options. **The dates of the footpath closure are:**

- **8pm Monday 17 July – 5am Friday 21 July 2023**
- **8pm Sunday 23 July – 5am Tuesday 25 July 2023**

Location of work and pedestrian detours during foreshore footpath closure





Temporary partial closure of the footpath at Headland Park

Between Monday 24 July and Saturday 12 August 2023, BESIX Watpac will be relining the seawater pipes underneath the footpath at Headland Park. This work will take place during standard construction hours which are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 6pm Saturday. During the work, a temporary worksite will be established, and the footpath will be partially closed as shown on the map below. The temporary worksite will be in place 24/7 for up to three weeks. **Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, and we do not expect the work to be noisy.**
