

# Notification – Five Dock

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovia Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

## Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is working with Sydney Water to upgrade water supply infrastructure and is delivering an excavator to the eastern construction site in Five Dock. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

**Preparation and installation of new water supply connections** in front of the western site in Great North Road will occur **between 6pm and 5am on Monday 31 July, Thursday 3, Friday 4, Monday 7 and Thursday 10 August 2023**. The contingency date is Friday 11 August 2023.

**Delivery of an excavator to the eastern construction site** will occur overnight on **Thursday 3 August 2023 between 10pm and 4am**. The contingency date is overnight on Friday 4 August 2023. The delivery is expected to take around an hour.

### The work will include:

- Flushing, dewatering and disinfection of water supply pipes
- Excavating trenches and installing additional pipes and joints
- Some concreting work in trenches
- Backfilling or covering of trenches with steel plates between shifts
- Backfilling and sealing of excavated areas upon completion of all the work
- Parking the semi-trailer on the eastern side of Great North Road for the excavator delivery (see map overleaf)
- Unloading the excavator from the semi-trailer and driving it inside the site shed via Second Avenue
- Driving the semi-trailer offsite

### What to expect:

- There will be some noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible. Any highly noisy work such as concrete cutting must be **completed before 12.00am (midnight)**
- The footpath on Great North Road will need to be closed on some nights with a pedestrian detour in place
- Clean water will be released into the gutter during the flushing process
- Three (3) parking spaces on Great North road in front of St Albans church will be closed during the utility work
- Rubber mats will be placed on the road to minimise noise when the excavator is being unloaded
- Some parking spaces on Second Avenue and Great North Road will be closed temporarily during the delivery

### Equipment used:


Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: excavators, semi-trailer, vacuum truck, light vehicles, trailers, plate compactor, concrete truck, concrete saw, lighting towers, tool van, road plates, road mats, electric tools and hand tools.

### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including pedestrian detours, stop-slow traffic controls and lane closures on Great North Road and Second Avenue.

Two-way traffic will be maintained under traffic control guidance while the oversized vehicle is parked on Great North Road. Second Avenue between Waterview Street and Great North Road will be closed briefly while the excavator is driven into the site.
