Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024 with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have four metro lines, with 46 stations and 113 kilometres of new metro rail.

Laing O'Rourke is delivering the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Upcoming work in the Railway Institute Driveway, Central Station

From **7am-6pm Thursday 3 and Friday 4 August 2023**, work will be undertaken in the Railway Institute Driveway to reinstate a fence, bollards and tactiles adjacent to 101 Chalmers Street.

Fencing will be delivered and installed around the work area outside of standard construction hours from **8pm Wednesday 2 August** to **12am Thursday 3 August** and removed from **8pm Sunday 6 August** to **12am Monday 7 August**. The ATF fencing, shadecloth and a bin will be brought in and removed during these periods by a tipper truck and the team will endeavour to keep noise to a minimum.

What to expect

- Access to the Railway Institute Driveway will be maintained at all times
- During standard work hours, traffic control will be located in the Driveway to safely guide local traffic, pedestrians and other road users.
- Machinery and equipment used during this work includes tipper trucks, construction vehicles, construction tools including hand and power tools, jack hammers and concrete saws.
- Some construction vehicle movements should be expected in and around the work area.
- While work is being undertaken, it is **business as usual** for adjacent businesses. Access to these businesses will be maintained.
